Peace

Growing up in the 70's, It seemed to me that everyone wanted to live in peace. People would hold up two fingers to form a V and say "Peace." There was a popular symbol with an upside down "Y" in a circle that symbolized "Peace." The song "Let There be Peace on Earth", although written in 1955, found new life on the radio and in many church hymnals.

Lyrics:

"Let there be peace on earth, and let it begin with me Let There Be Peace on Earth, the peace that was meant to be With God as our Father, brothers all are we Let me walk with my brother, in perfect harmony. Let peace begin with me, let this be the moment now. With every step I take, tet this be my solemn vow To take each moment and live, each moment in peace eternally Let there be peace on earth, and let it begin with me" (Lyrics by Jill Jackson-Miller and Sy Miller)

Should Christians strive to live in Peace? Absolutely! And here's why Romans 14:9 ... "Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification."

The message is simple, "Let there be peace on earth and let it begin with me." But to consistently live out this message of brotherly love and peace seems impossible for us. But what a world it would be if we could always greet one another with the peace and love of Christ.

God created us to live in harmony with Him and one another, but since the fall, it has been impossible for mankind to live in harmony. There have always been conflicts, between people, nations and even churches. But why? Why can't we just live together in "the peace that was meant to be" when God created the world and everything and everyone in it? I think back when this song was written in 1955, a promise, or an oath could be sealed with a handshake and both parties would do their best to fulfill their promise. But today, I think the definition has changed from an oath to a proposal. I will try to keep my promise, instead of I will keep my promise, my oath.

God has made many promises to His Children in His Word and as Christians, we trust God at His Word, because He is faithful.

Word meaning changes overtime, but God's promises are covenants, trustworthy and true, because God is unchanging. God's oaths are trustworthy yesterday, today and tomorrow. And we can look forward to the promise that one day, we will walk with our brothers and sisters and our God in perfect harmony and the peace of Christ will be overflowing and encompass our very being. Oh what a day that will be when peace will cover the earth.

As we begin this season of Advent, let's invite the peace that the Christ Child, the Prince of Peace brings to change us so that peace can truly begin with us.
