The Power of Forgiveness

As Christians, we are taught to forgive others, as we have been forgiven. Forgiveness is powerful and it can help us heal from our deepest hurts. However, forgiveness is hard, especially when we have been deeply wounded. But when we can cultivate a forgiving heart, we will begin to find the peace in our lives we all desire. Forgiveness has benefits, it allows us to live in the freedom God offers us. Holding onto grudges and resentment negatively can impact our physical and spiritual health, as well, because it can lead to anger and bitterness when we dwell on the negativity. We need to let things go and allow God to use what was hurtful for something good.

When we cultivate a heart of forgiveness, we can improve our health and our overall well-being, because un-forgiveness is like drinking poison hoping the other person will die. Forgiveness can lower our stress levels and improve relationships. When we embrace the command to forgive as we have been forgiven, we allow the grace of God to envelope us to make us better witnesses to his love.

True forgiveness is a process, it takes time and effort to release the hurt and resentment we feel towards others for what they have done. But it's worth it. Forgiveness is not the same as forgetting what someone did, but it does mean we have to stop bringing it back up, once it has been forgiven. 


