Why We Celebrate World Communion Sunday as Methodist

World Communion Sunday is observed on the first Sunday in October. It's a day set aside to celebrate with other Christians around the world from different denominations as we partake in the Lord's Supper. It's a time to reflect on the unity, fellowship and a global witness of our Christian faith.

World Communion Sunday began in 1933 at Shadyside Presbyterian Church in Pittsburgh, PA., as an initiative to bring churches together at a time of global uncertainty. It was during the Great Depression, which lasted from 1929 - 1939. It was also the time leading up to World War II. It was a time the world needed unity and solidarity of purpose.

Today World Communion Sunday reminds us of the uncertainty of our own time, with conflict raging in Ukraine and the Middle East. So coming together to share communion is a powerful testimony to the hope we have as Christians that we are united as the body of Christ, even as many nations and the world seem so divided.

While Holy Communion has always been a sacrament of the Methodist Church, World Communion Sunday emphasizes our inter-consecutiveness as believers around the world. While we may express our faith in a variety of ways, we all celebrate our shared Christian faith in Jesus Christ when we break bread together and share the cup during Holy Communion.

Breaking the bread and drinking the cup symbolizes Jesus' sacrifice, which is central to the Christian faith, in every Christian denomination, whether, Presbyterian, Catholic, Lutheran, Baptist or Methodist.

Paul wrote in I Corinthians 10:16-17, "Is not the cup of thanksgiving for which we give thanks a participation in the blood of Christ? And is not the bread that we break a participation in the body of Christ? Because there is one loaf, we, who are many, are one body, for we all share the one loaf." So regardless of our differences, we are all part of the same body in Christ.

World Communion Sunday reminds us that we are indeed one body, that is not confined to one country, culture or language. Christianity is a global movement that spans across borders, customs and traditions. We are all called to be the hands, feet and voice of Jesus, far beyond our church walls.

The Communion Table has always held a significant place in Christian worship. It's a symbol of hospitality, inviting all who believe to come and partake of the elements. We recognize it is the Lord's Table and it is a sacred time and place where we come to commune with our Lord and Savior, remembering Jesus' words in Matthew 26:26-28. "Jesus took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take and eat; this is my body." Then he took a cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins."

World Communion Sunday remains a Christian tradition embraced by a variety of Christian denominations as an act of worship, and it stands as a powerful reminder of the unity and hope that is found in Christ, especially during uncertain times.




#### THANKSGIVING BASKET MINISTRY September 29th through October 27th
