Labor Day And Christian Service

As Christians, what is our perspective about working hard, serving others and honoring the Lord with our labor?

Labor Day for many, marks the end of summer with barbecues, pool parties or that last trip to the beach. But Labor Day holds a deeper meaning, when we recognize it is a day we set aside to pay tribute to the contributions of the many workers who are instrumental for our society to flourish. It gives us the opportunity to reflect on the value of work, the dignity it provides, and the many ways we can be in service to others and God.

To the Christian, work is more than simply earning a living, it's a vocation, a calling that gives us purpose. In the very beginning, God placed Adam in the garden of Eden to work it and take care of it. Which demonstrates that work is understood to be an integral part of the human experience. It should not be seen as a burden or a punishment, but as a way for us to participate in God's plan for humanity.

The Apostle Paul teaches us in Colossians 3:23-24 "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving." When we understand labor in this way, it transforms our perspective that it is not just work, but rather an opportunity to glorify God with our work.

Whether you work for a paycheck, or you volunteer to be the hands and feet of Jesus to others, the principle is the same. Just like Jesus served others through teaching, feeding, healing and even washing the disciples feet, we should labor in a way that loves our neighbors and serves God. Jesus' labor was selfless and for the Christian our work should not just be about personal gain, but about contributing to the well being of others as well. I am so pleased how our church offers so many opportunities to labor for Jesus, through our food pantry, community breakfast, backpack ministry, thanksgiving baskets, toy ministry, music ministries and various outreach events

Labor Day is a reminder that every job, no matter how big or how small, is significant in bringing the love of Jesus to others.

Scripture reminds us there is a rhythm to life through the creation narrative; God creates for six days and rests on the seventh and so should we set apart a time for worship and for rest. We are told to set aside a day, the Sabbath and keep it holy. Rest is not just a break from work, but necessary for us to refresh our bodies, renew our spirits and connect with God. Which can seem difficult in our fast-paced world. This is not a suggestion, but a commandment for our well-being physically, emotionally and spiritually. We can never feel whole without rest.

Labor Day is a day to appreciate the value of work and reflect on the fruits of our labor as we give thanks to God for the work he has provided for us. And reflect, am I using the gifts and abilities that I have been given to serve others? If so great! If not, maybe this is a time to dedicate your labor and align your work and your faith through your labor.




THANKSGIVING BASKET MINISTRY September 29th through October 27th
