

10 Book 5 of THE BIBLE MINUTE TO WIN IT GAMES



GENESIS TO REVELATION

Items needed:

Six signs or posters with the names of six books of the Bible written on them Music stands

Directions:

Before you are the names of six books of the Bible. Your task, if you choose to accept it, is to arrange these books in the order they appear in the Bible. You can shuffle the names of the books as many times as necessary, but you only have 60 seconds to get them in the right order and win.

66

Items needed:

66 dominoes

Directions:

There are 66 dominoes in this stack, one for each of the 66 books of the Bible. Your task is to stack the 66 Dominoes, one after the other, on the table, in a continuous line before knocking them down. In order to win this game, you must stand all 66 dominoes up and then knock them all down in one shot. If you can set up and knock down all 66 dominoes before time runs out, you win.

Note: For this challenge you may find it better to set the time at 2-3 minutes rather than just 1 minute.

CUP STACKER

Items needed:

39 Red Solo Cups 27 Blue Solo Cups

Preparation:

Set all the cups on a table, with none stacked on top of one another.

Directions:

There are 66 books in the Bible - 39 in the Old Testament, 27 in the New. Your task in this challenge is to sort these 66 cups into two stacks: 39 red in one stack, 27 blue in the other. Complete this challenge in 60 seconds or less, and you'll win a prize.

HOW FAR CAN YOU GO?

Items needed:

None

Preparation:

Choose 2-3 players for this game

Directions:

How well do you know your Bible, and how well do you know the 66 books inside? In this challenge, you will recite as many books of the Bible as you can, in order, in one minute. Think and speak carefully, because you will be competing with other students. The player who can go the furthest in the Bible without missing a book wins.



Items needed:

None

Directions:

There are 39 books in the Old Testament, from Genesis to Malachi. In this challenge, you will attempt to name all 39 books from the Old Testament in 60 seconds or less. If you can make it from Genesis to Malachi without skipping a book, you'll win!

BIBLE SCRABBLE

Items needed:

A bag full of Scrabble tiles

Directions:

The bag in your hand contains a complete set of letters from a game of Scrabble. In this challenge, you must scoop letters from the bag and quickly assemble those letters into three books from the Bible. You can spell any three books from the Bible you like, from Job to Lamentations, but you must spell three in 60 seconds or less to win.

MAJORS AND MINORS

Items needed:

One empty egg carton 16 Ping-pong balls

Preparation:

Write the names of all the Major and Minor Prophets on the Ping Pong balls, one on each ball.

Directions:

This challenge will test how well you know your Old Testament Prophets. There are twelve Minor Prophets in the Old Testament, and there are sixteen prophets written on the ping-pong balls. Your task is to sort the Minor Prophets from the Major and stack them all into the egg crate. If you can get the twelve Minor Prophets into the crate together before time runs out, you win!

150 PENNIES

Items needed:

A big pile of pennies

Directions:

There are 150 chapters in the longest book in the Bible, the book of Psalms. In this challenge, you must move exactly 150 pennies into a separate pile, one for every Psalm. Finish this challenge in 60 seconds or less, and you win.

GOSPEL SCRAMBLE

Items needed:

Flashcards or Scrabble tiles

Preparation:

Pick out cards or Scrabble tiles with enough letters to allow you to spell out Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.

Directions:

There are four Gospels in the New Testament that tell the story of Jesus. In this challenge, you must sort the cards/tiles on the table before you and spell out the names of these four books. Get one, and the others will become easier, but hurry. You only have 60 seconds to complete this challenge.



Items needed:

A white board A marker

Directions:

There are 66 books of the Bible. Of those 66, there are seven pairs of books that have a part one and a part two. In this challenge, you must name the seven pairs of books by writing them on the white board.

Notes:

The correct answers are Samuel, Kings, Chronicles, Corinthians, Thessalonians, Timothy, and Peter.

If you like, you can offer a bonus prize if the player can also name 1, 2, and 3 John as the only trio of books.
