
who will usher in:

There will be no 9:30 a.m. worship services on December 24th and December 31st.





As we feast on our turkeys and count our blessings we, the leaders of New Market UMC, are especially grateful for each individual and family

in our church community. We are grateful for every prayer, dollar, and hour of service shared. Together we teach and transform lives every week.

If you have already turned in your commitment card and/or Thanksgiving offering THANK YOU!! You are a part of the strong beginning we celebrate today. If your commitment card is still on the table, or your Thanksgiving OFFERING is still in your wallet, PLEASE come to church Sunday or stop in the office to turn in your precious gift.

Our Finance team is anxiously awaiting the return of your commitment card to determine our financial readiness to meet next year's budget. The team has sharpened their pencils, scrutinized budget lines, made necessary adjustments, created and eliminated categories (a great thank you to Thersa Dowling for her patience in implementing all the changes). Even with the intense pencil sharpening and scrutiny the budget will still have a \$19,000 deficit based on current giving trends for 2017. Your faithful commitment to consistent giving and tithing will enable all of our vital ministries to be fully funded for the coming year. If you were not present at worship on Giving Sunday you will be receiving the Giving Campaign packet in the mail. Please return your commitment card at your earliest possible convenience.

As of November 21, 2017, we have received **\$8,400** toward parsonage/schoolhouse debt reduction. Thank you for your one-time per year debt reduction Thanksgiving gifts. Look for the downward dropping thermometer in the sanctuary that will inspire us to reduce and eliminate this debt.
