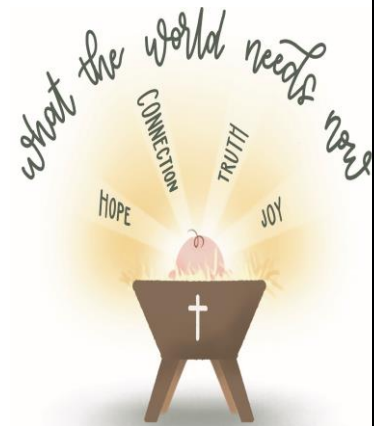
*“What the world needs now is love, sweet love, it’s the only thing that there’s just too little of!”*

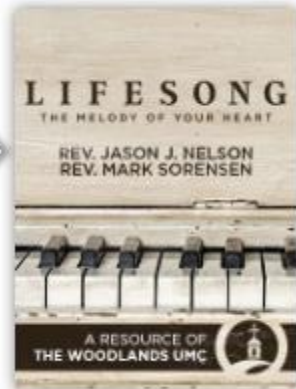
We are praying for you to experience the lifegiving blessings of Christmas. With hope,

This school year's first quarter has been an exciting one for Hope 4 Kids. Volunteers at Mt. Carmel UMC prepare 48 packs of food for students at Spring Ridge Elementary and Oakdale Middle Schools, while New Market UMC prepare 37 packs of food for students at New Market Elementary, New Market Middle, Deer Crossing Elementary, and Oakdale Elementary. That is 85 students in our local community that are being blessed by our Hope 4 Kids program!

Before those bags get into the lockers of food insecure children there are more than 50 volunteers needed each month to manage inventory, fundraise, order food, shop for additional items, deliver to the schools, and, of course, prepare the packs. ## An update on the financial health of the church from the Finance Committee

Because both giving and attendance were down in October, we are slipping behind in meeting the budgeted goal for giving for this year. However, we are ahead of last year's giving for the January-October thanks to overall strong giving. Thank you!

Below you can compare 2017 to 2018's giving through October 31st and year end goals.

The mortgage debt has been reduced by \$48,418.68 over the last twelve months thanks to the many designated mortgage reduction gifts from you, as well as our applying the full rent from the parsonage to pay down the mortgage. In the past much of that rent money was used to close gaps in our budget. Last year the Finance Team challenged the congregation to give enough to fully support our church's functioning so that we could use the difference between the required monthly payment on the loan and the rent we receive for the parsonage to make principal only payments. Thank you for taking up that challenge and besting it by giving additional funds to pay down the loan.

The mortgage debt has been reduced to \$109,581.32. The original balance on this five year loan was \$177,871.02 in January of 2016. This means that of the \$68,289.70 in principal that we have paid off over the last years, \$48,418.68 of it (almost 71%) was paid down this year. Two more years of similarly strong giving will have our church debt free and, therefore, more free to focus more on ministering to our community.

We are so "very thankful" for the tithing of our committed and steadfast congregation. The Finance committee would like to wish you all a blessed Thanksgiving.

### LIFT (Ladies in Faith Together)

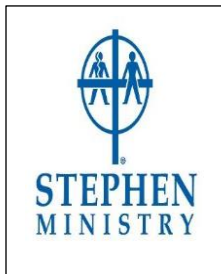

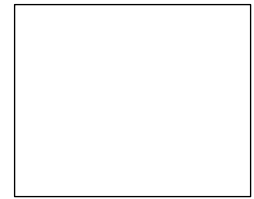
