BUILDING UPDATE

The VAL (Visualizing Abundant Life) Team has been working diligently with each other and the architect to finalize the exterior elevations of the new proposed ministry center. The next step is to take these elevations to the town for any feedback and then to present them to the congregation. This has been a 3-year process to get to this point. The team started the process with the intention to add restrooms to the rear of the sanctuary and locate handicapped parking adjacent to the sanctuary; however, since the transfer of the cemetery did not occur, it was decided to renovate and expand the Ed Building to provide additional space for Sunday School and preschool classes, as well as other ministries. We will let everyone know when initial discussions with the town have concluded and that outcome. Keep your team in prayer.
