#### Monday (7/29)- Deuteronomy 1: 19-38

Have you ever had a perfect opportunity placed in front of you from the Lord and let fear rule your decision? In what ways can you place your trust in the providence of the Lord when fearful opportunities arise?

#### **Tuesday (7/30)- Deuteronomy 3: 21-29**

Why was Moses denied access to the promised land (Deuteronomy 32: 51-52)? Does this seem like a minor offense to you? How would it feel to be denied an end goal when you have placed so much obedience, faith, and time in achieving that goal?

#### Wednesday (7/31)- Deuteronomy 4: 1-8

Do you think the nation of Israel still honors the laws and decrees that the Lord set forth to their ancestors? Give examples of why or why not.

### Thursday (8/1)- Deuteronomy 4: 41-43

Why did the Lord set up cities of refuge for those who committed involuntary manslaughter? Where are the places in the world today where one can seek refuge from retaliation?

#### Friday (8/2)- Deuteronomy 6:1-9

In practicing Jewish households, there is placed a "Mezuzah" at the most frequently used doorway that contains a tiny strip of paper with today's text on it. The tradition is to place your fingers on the "Mezuzah" and then place your finger on your lips to remember who and whose you are every time you exit the house. How could a similar practice at your own home change your attitude as you enter a weary world?

#### Saturday (8/3)- Mark 7: 1-14

Some theologians consider this passage of the gospel of Mark the most radical words that Jesus ever spoke. Why do you think they consider Jesus' proclamation as radical?
