Friday (5/24)- Romans 8:12-17

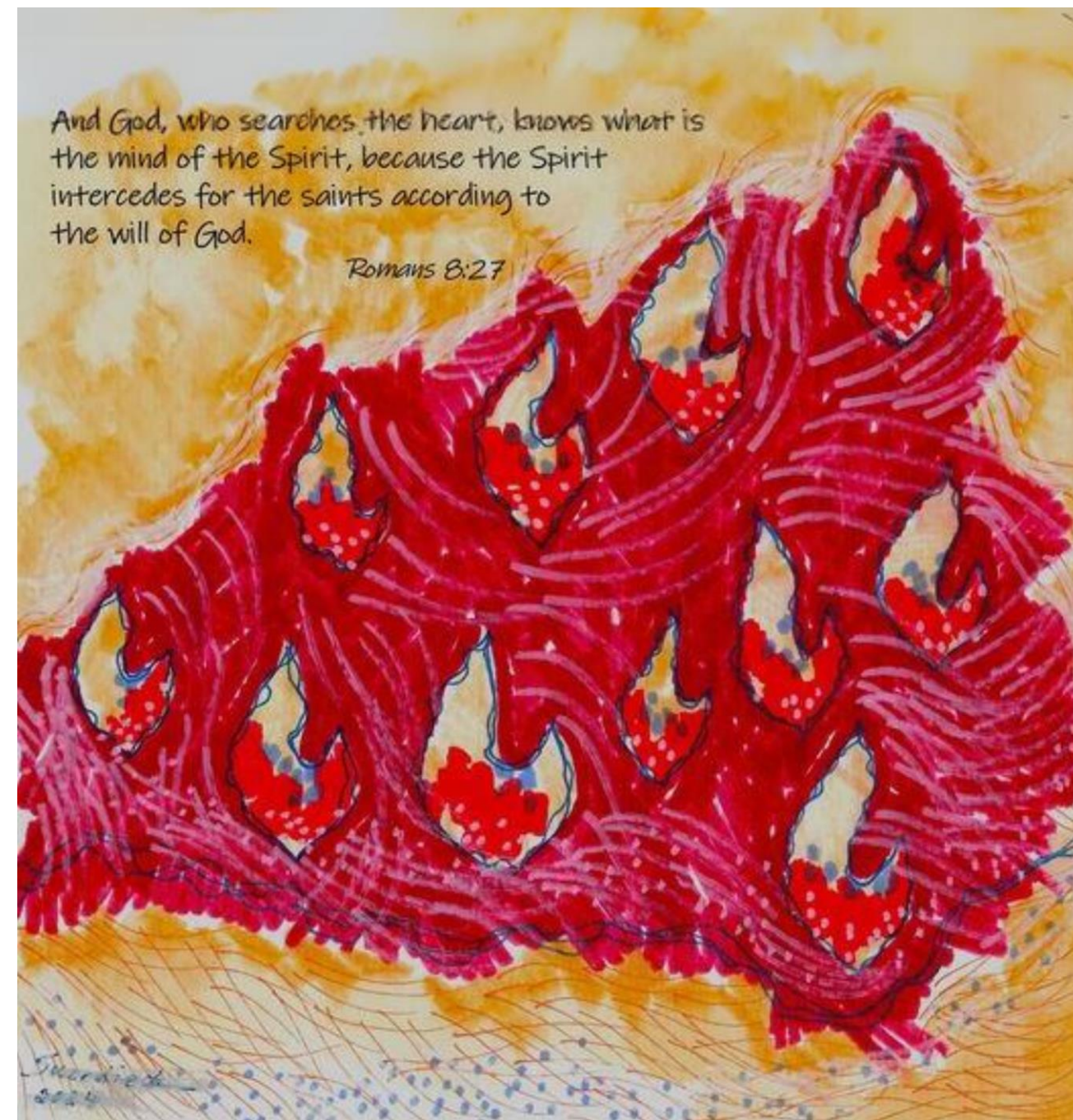
Can you describe the feelings you have when you meditate on God adopting you as a treasured son or daughter? Give thanks to God for calling us "Children of God".
