#### **VAL UPDATE**

The VAL team has been on a short hiatus after presenting the rendering to the congregation on November 24th. Since this presentation, we have hired a land surveyor who recently completed a survey of our property. In the coming months, we will file the water extension plan to bring water service to the education building from Main Street and plan to make an application for the site improvements to the Town. When there is a hearing scheduled before the Town we will alert the congregation for public testimony of support!

#### PREPARING FOR FUTURE EXPANSION

On December 19th four graves were exhumed from the Education Building grounds and reinterred in the sanctuary graveyard. The graves dated from 1929 and the 1950's. The Church Council, on recommendation from the VAL (Building) Team, relocated the graves to make room for the future expansion of the Education Building. Religious ceremonies were performed by Pastor Scott during the exhumation and reinterment. The reinterred graves were placed at the rear of the sanctuary graveyard.
