This letter is just a reminder of a few things for the show week.

**When should I arrive at the theatre?**

You should arrive at the theatre, Gwyn Hall, 1 hour before the performance time.

**What should I wear to the theatre?**

Please come dressed in your costume, you will arrive and leave in the same costume.

**How long is the show?**

The show runs at around 2.5hrs

**Where do we drop off and pick up students?**

All students must be dropped off and signed in to the stage door, after the show they must be signed out at collected at the stage door. This is non-negotiable as it's part of our licensing and fire risk assessments, please do not ask for students to be collected from anywhere else as this will not be accomodated. We aim to get students out as quickly as we can but as everyone has to be signed out, there will be a wait.

**Do I need to bring anything?**

Please only bring a drink (ideally water) and a small snack, we take no responsibility for loss or damage of any electronics such as phones/iPads etc, they aren't needed.

**Hair/makeup**

Hair, if long, should be up and out of the face, not too neat as they are orphan children, make up should be basic, please feel free to add some 'dirt' with make up or face paint
