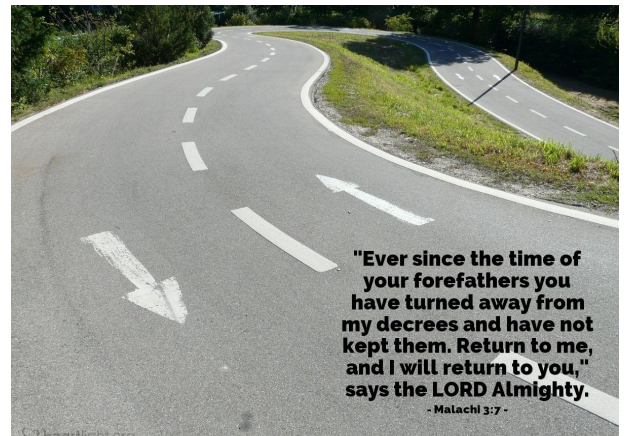
Cross Country - Violet Buchholz
