Greeting Families and Supporters,

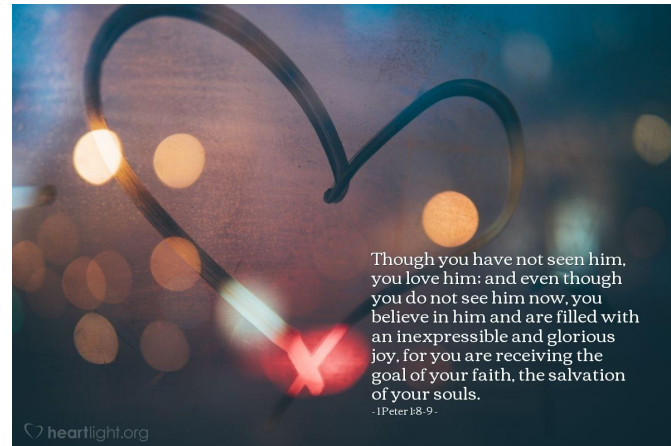

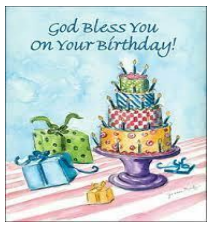
