Help us fill the Toys for Tots bins!

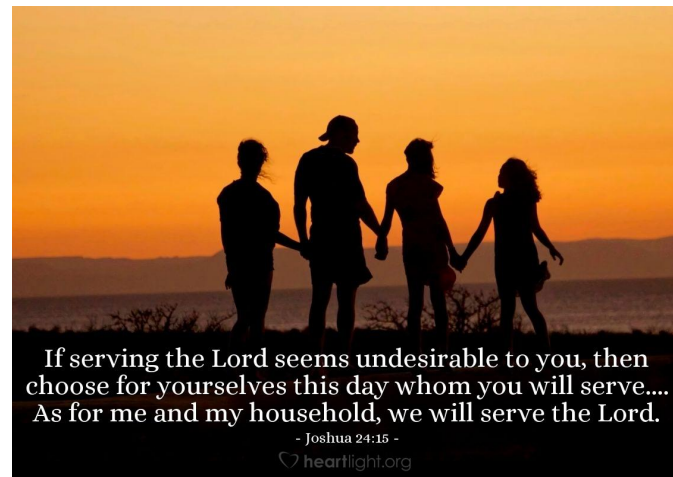


Greeting Families and Supporters,

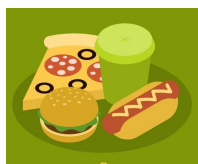

After Kringle was named Wisconsin's State Pastry, Uncle Mike set out to make the best kringle around. Shortly after his journey began, they announced there would be a North American Kringle Competition. We entered our Sea Salt Caramel Pecan Kringle into the competition and the rest is

history. Our customers tell us daily that this is the best Kringle (even Best Pastry) they have ever had.

Our Kringle is in the traditional pretzel shape of that the Danish made. They get baked daily at our facilities here in Green Bay, WI. Check out the flavors we offer down below. All of our fillings are homemade in-house. To achieve the best quality kringle dough, we only use European butter as opposed to a butter/shortening mix, which many bakers have switched too.

	Our Turtle Kringle won 2nd place at the Wisconsin Kringle Competition. We bake the kringle with no fillings, cut it in half after baking and add a Caramel Cream.		Our Cream Cheese filling is very smooth and makes an excellent treat that will please everyone. We use cream cheese from the Green Bay area in our homemade filling.
