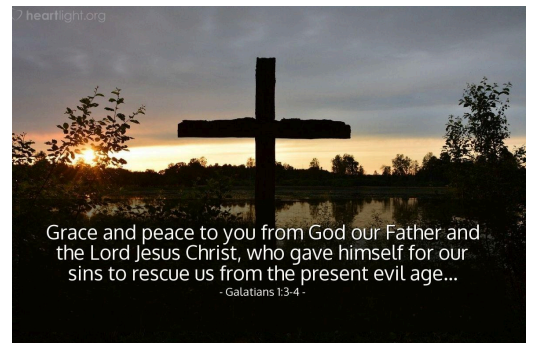

IN NEED OF SUPPLIES - The school is in need of white paper towels for art class and the kitchen and kleenexes for the classrooms. Thank you so much for helping us.

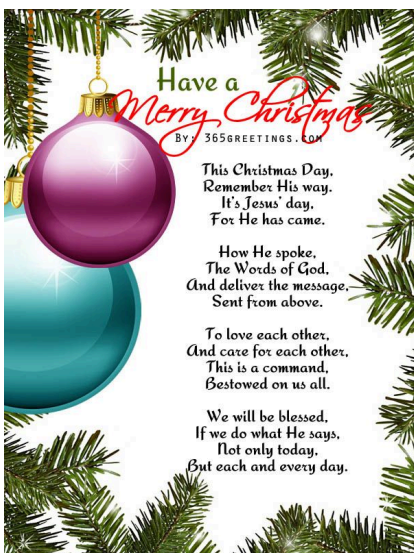
