ACADEMIC DECATHLON - The new thing we tried out this year turned out to be a very successful trial! Academic Decathlon, which began in 1968, is a country-wide competition for high schools, designed to encourage academic excellence from students of all abilities. There is a separate curriculum from their regular studies, and the curriculum is based on a theme. This year's theme was *The Roaring Twenties*. The subjects that are covered in Academic Decathlon are Math, Science, Literature, Social Science, Art, Music, Economics, Speech, Interview and Essay. It is INCREDIBLY rigorous and challenging, and it kept us busy from the beginning of school until the end of February. Our very first year, as a small school, was very successful: we made it all the way to the State competition in Green Bay! This is a huge achievement, and we are so proud to have represented our school in such a long-standing, respected program. Some of the highlights of our State competition: Julia Young won several awards for top scores in individual subject areas. Josh Lange won a trophy and scholarship opportunities for being the top scoring student at our school. Everyone did very well and had at least one subject that they tested particularly well in.
