As we put the finishing touches on preparation for this year, remember to give thanks to the Lord for all things! He is truly an awesome God!

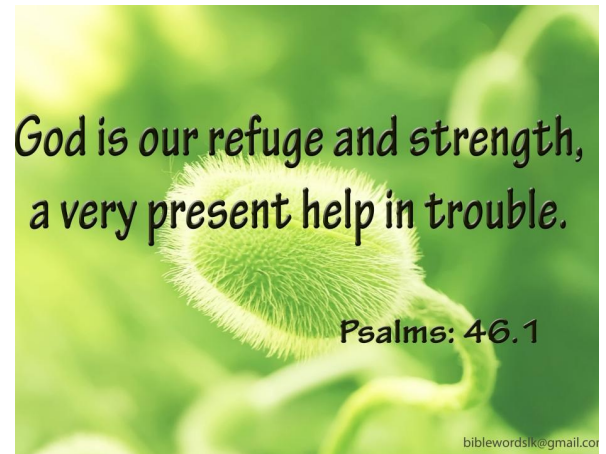

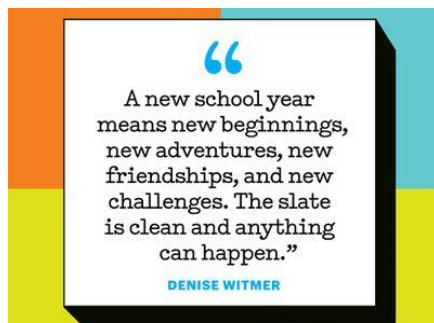

2022 - 2023 HOT LUNCH PROGRAM

Wolf River Lutheran High School serves a hot lunch every Wednesday that is coordinated by the student body parents. The parents are divided into teams with each team having a group leader that coordinates the menu for their team. The group leaders ask each team member to prepare and bring an item or two to school on their scheduled lunch date to serve to the students and staff.

Each group will serve on the assigned date. If there is no school on the Wednesday of your week or if there is an early dismissal, hot lunch will not be scheduled.

Lunch is served from 11:42 a.m. - 12:08 p.m.. If you are serving, please arrive 35-40 minutes prior to serving to make sure you have enough time to set up. Paper products and plasticware are supplied in the kitchen, along with serving utensils. We have microwaves, an oven, a stovetop, and Nesco's for you to use if needed. We also ask that you clean up after the meal and make sure that everything is washed and returned to its appropriate location.

If you or anyone in your family is not feeling well, PLEASE let your group leader know that you will be unable to prepare food that week. Please make sure to communicate with your group leader if there are any other concerns.
