Welcome Vicar Kaiser!

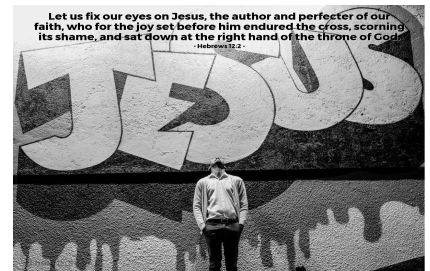
Greeting Families and Supporters,
