ATTENDANCE POLICY REMINDER: (See page 7 in the student/parent handbook)

If your child has a dental or doctor appointmnet written verification is required. Please ask your provider for a note from their office. Written verification of excused absences, when applicable, is expected within three school days of the absence(s) or the student risks having the absence(s) declared unexcused by the administration. When the school is unable to reach a parent or guardian when a child is absent, and the school is not notified, the absence is considered unexcused. The parent/student handbook requests that parents or guardians contact the office by 8:00 a.m. on the day of the absence. Parents, please remember to call your student in for illness or absence. It is very difficult to reach parents when voicemails are not set up. This would alleviate attendance problems if the school was contacted for a student's absence. Together we can resolve attendance concerns by keeping communication open.
