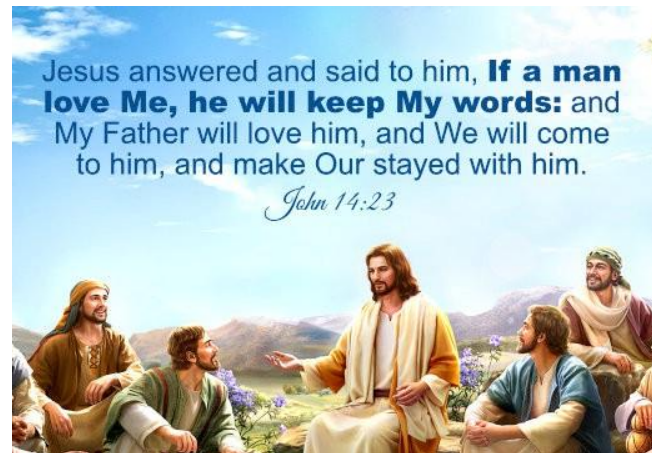


### Greeting Families and Supporters,
