# Community Service Activity Log

#### **Requirement Overview:**

Community service is service without pay to a non-profit agency/organization, an individual, or a group in need.

- Students must complete 80 hours of service before the finals of the graduating semester of their senior year. Service may begin the summer prior to a student's freshman year.
- For students enrolled after the first semester of their freshman year, the requirement will be prorated to equal three hours times the number of semesters enrolled at Wolf River Lutheran High School.
- Service must be performed outside of school hours unless under the supervision of the classroom teacher and directly tied to the curriculum. (Service-Learning)
- All community service must be pre-approved by the community service coordinator/guidance counselor.
- Childcare/babysitting count only when done for a non-profit organization.
- Helping family members is done out of love and is not considered community service.

#### **Requirement Guidelines:**

- 1. Choose a service activity in your church or community.
- 2. Pick up a **Community Service Activity Log sheet** from the community service coordinator/guidance counselor.
- 3. Fill out the time log portion of the sheet and return it when the activity is complete. Your on-sire supervisor must sign the form.

#### Graduation Requirements:

- 1. If service hours are not completed before finals, student will not graduate.
- 2. The student will be able to walk with the other graduates.
- 3. A signed Diploma will be given after all community service hours have been completed.
