**Riding Safety:** Riding electric bicycles must comply with Australian regulations and requirements. Our store is not responsible for any fines or personal injuries caused by speeding or violating traffic rules. Please obey traffic rules and ensure your own safety while riding.

**Battery Charging:** Our electric bicycles use lithium batteries, and using uncertified chargers may result in battery damage or personal injury. Our store is not responsible for any issues caused using uncertified chargers. Please use original or certified chargers for charging.

Charging Location: When charging the battery, you must obtain permission from the landlord or property manager and must charge it in a safe environment. Charging in unsafe places such as bedrooms is prohibited. Our store is not responsible for any accidents or losses caused by violation of this regulation.

## **Maintenance and Care of Electric Bicycles**

Bicycles should be regularly maintained and serviced every two months or one thousand kilometers at our store or repair shop. Before riding, please check the tires yourself, such as tire pressure. If the tire pressure is insufficient, please inflate the tires immediately to avoid potential safety hazards during travel.

## **Safety Charging Instructions**

Only use chargers with Australian regulatory compliance markings (RCM).

Always use the correct charger provided by us; do not use incorrect power outputs (voltage and current) to charge the battery. (For example: a 60V charger cannot charge a 48V battery, and a 48V charger cannot charge a 60V battery); the charging space must be in a dry, cool outdoor area. Ensure that there are no flammable items around the charging space and maintain a distance of at least 1.5 meters from flammable items.

A single power outlet can only charge one battery, not two or more batteries simultaneously. When the charging is complete and the green light is on, please unplug the charger as soon as possible, otherwise overcharging may shorten the battery life or pose safety hazards.

Do not charge the battery while sleeping or away from home.

After the battery is fully charged, disconnect the device from the charger. Do not overcharge for more than 12 hours.

Do not use devices and charge them on beds simultaneously. Devices such as phones, tablets, and e-cigarettes left on blankets, sheets, and clothes may overheat and catch fire.

Do not use swollen, bulging, leaking, or overheated batteries and do not charge them. If the device has cracks, dents, punctures, or crushes, do not use or charge it.
