### **Standings**

## What are Challenge Points?

Challenge Points are earned through easy and seamless competitions each week. Golfers with 3 or more Challenge Points earn a spot in the Championship Flight held Week 4. The golfer with the best golf score in the Championship Flight held Week 4 is League Champion!

## **Challenge Point Competitions**

Below are summaries of the 4 Challenge Points that can be earned.

1)King of the Hill

King of the Hill is determined by drawing at first tee box. For this *Challenge Point*, golfers try to beat the King of the Hill by getting the best golf score to earn *Challenge Point*.

King of the Hill gets best golf score-King of the Hill earns 1 Challenge Point

<u>Any</u> golfer in foursome beats King of the Hill- All golfers, except King of the Hill earn 1 *Challenge Point* 

2)Par 3 Shoot Out (par 3 course)

Hit 5 greens or more on drive - earn 1 Challenge Point

Bonus Challenge Point! Hit 7 or more greens on drive - earn additional Challenge Point

- 3 Bingo Bango -score card can be picked up at front desk or printed off (will be emailed prior to play).
  - 1. 2 points awarded for each hole. Most points in foursome at end wins 1 *Challenge Point* (points are given to each golfer on tie)
    - Point 1: Longest drive in fairway or closest to pin earns point
    - Point 2: Once all players are on green first to putt in earns point
      - \*Furthest ball from pin putts first.
      - \*1st golfer to putt in on first try only earns point.
- 4 Using cumulative golf scores for first 3 weeks, golfers finishing in the top 25% or better earn 1 Challenge Point

WEEK 4: Championship Flights

Golfers who accumulate 3 or more *Challenge Points* earn spot in Championship Flight. Golfer with best golf score in Championship Flight held Week 4 is League Champion.
