

**I'm Going to the
Bathroom!**



First, I raise my hand to ask my teacher if I may leave to use the bathroom. “May I use the bathroom?”



I may need to take a
bathroom pass, or put my
name on the board.



It's important that my teacher
always knows where I am.
“Let's stay safe!”



I walk quietly in the hall,
keeping my hands to my side. I
may quietly say hello to others
or wave.



The hallway is a quiet place
for going from one room to
another. “I can be quiet.”

When I get to the bathroom, I look to see if there are any stalls with open doors.



If the doors are all closed, I wait. I wait behind other kids. “I wait quietly”

When there is an open door, I
go into the stall and close and
lock the door.



There are many different kinds of locks! I slide or turn until the lock keeps the door closed. I can ask an adult for help if I'm having trouble.



I use the toilet at school just like at home. After I'm done peeing or pooping, I make sure to wipe myself clean and flush the toilet! I push down on the handle or push the button on top.



Now I unlock the door and wash my hands with soap at the sink. Some sinks have automatic water so I put my hands under the faucet. “Let’s wash hands!”



I use two paper towels to dry off my hands. Then I put the towels in the garbage or recycle bin. "I'm done!"



I check that my pants are pulled up right and I smile because I did it! Time to go back to my classroom.



If I need to, I put back the bathroom pass or erase my name from the board. I quietly sit down in my chair. “I’m ready to learn!”



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
