As Salaam Alaikum Dear Community,

In consultation with religious scholars, medical, and governmental officials regarding the present concern of the spread of Covid-19 (coronavirus) through gatherings, we have decided to suspend daily prayers and Jumuah, (Friday Religious services) beginning Friday 3/20/20, until further notice.

We will keep the city wide community up to date as everything progresses. The health and safety of our congregants is of utmost concern to the members of the Majlis. In Islam the priority is given to the safety of human life. In lieu of holding Jumuah, the individual Masjid will hold an online lecture, and the regular afternoon prayer should be made in lieu of the Jumuah prayer. It is recommended that Muslims use this time to engage in remembrance of Allah, sanitation of frequently used spaces, including masjid, and spending time with their families.

It is also recommended that all metro Atlanta Masaajid cancel Jumuah services at a minimum on a week to week basis until further notice to lessen the possibility of spreading the virus, and above all: "...place your trust in Allah. Surely, Allah loves those who place their trust in Him." (Qur'an, 3:159).

Please boost your immune system and thoroughly wash your hands to help to reduce the impact of the virus. Please remember to pay zakat and make donations to your respective Masjid on Friday via CashApp, PayPal, Mail, or other forms of payment.
