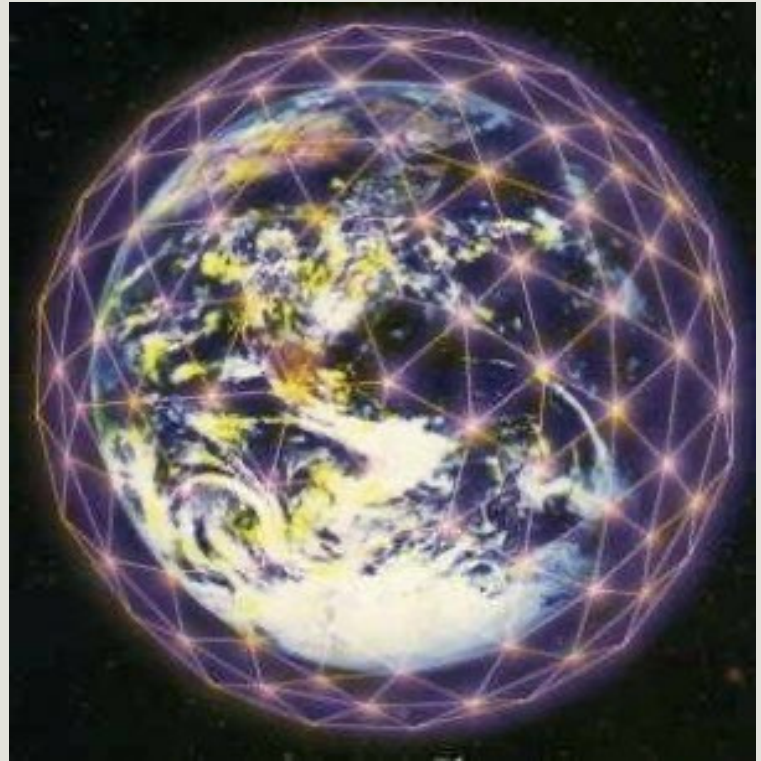
Due to this state of the world, we are experiencing chronic states of anxiety, stress and depression on a mass collective level.

The way of living as we know it has drastically changed since 2020.

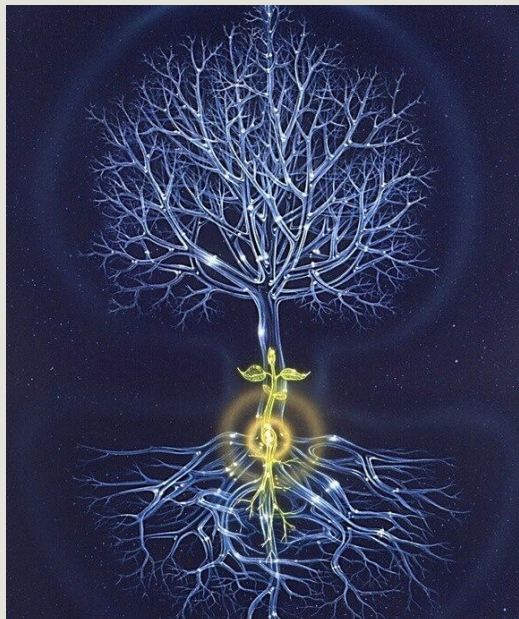
This has triggered deep unsafety and unrest in the global population.

- Permaculture

- Short and medium term accommodation for community members and volunteers
- Community Centers: Sacred, Natural, Academic and Recreational
- Healing and Wellness Centers
- All inclusive Eco-Villas
- Scenic Spaces: butterfly gardens, meditation gardens and river access

INTENTIONS

- To be an example community for the development as a society of future generations
- Offer self-development tools of meditation, yogic practices, permaculture farming, etc for people with limited resources and education
- Raise funds and serve as support for the needs of local communities, programs and people
- Create jobs with living wages for members of the native community
- Create a space where people can learn skills of leadership, conscious independence and community living and sharing
- Achieve complete self-sustainability
- Create a community devoted to being of service to the Earth and to each other

DONATIONS/INVESTMENT INTENTIONS

With any generous investments for the land, our first priority would be to utilize this money to go towards suiting amenities, accommodations and safety to those who will be working with and visiting the land

This includes:

- Proper security for the land and the community (fences and gates)
- Fully functioning water systems (for showers, kitchen sinks and laundry stations)
- Solar Panels (generating electricity for lights, internet modems, refrigerators, fans (ceiling and ground), a future woodshop / welding space, eventually air conditioning for indoor spaces such as the school on the property
- Purchase tools & materials for building homes, vertical / horizontal gardens, and landscaping maintenance for the land

EARTH DEDICATION

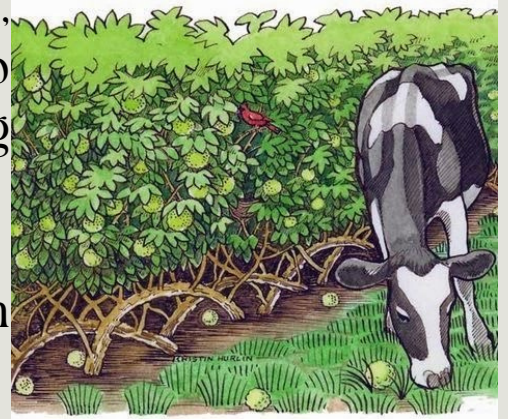
- Creation of biointensive gardens and food forests.
