Study guide: session #4

Acts chapters 11-14

1. Look at Acts 11:1-18. In verse 3, Peter is questioned about, “Why he went to the uncircumcised men and ate with them?” He explains the dream in the following verses. How would others become convinced the dream was true?
2. Look at Acts 12. Why does the author (Luke) mention these stories about James, Peter, and Herod? Look at verse 24. How would you define what “word of God” is and how it is used in this passage?
3. Look at Acts 13:13-43. How would you begin to summarize this sermon? Why does verse 41 include this passage from Habbakuk 1:5? Look at verse 48. How would you explain the relationship between being “destined for eternal life” and “becoming believers?”
4. Look at Acts 14:8-18. How do Paul and Barnabas explain *who* they are, and how do they explain *who* God is and *what* God does? What is the effect, looking at verses 19-20?
