2. Read Acts 24: 10-21. How is Paul interpreting his own tradition of faith through the *lens* of death and resurrection? What more do we learn about the resurrection of the dead?
3. Read Acts 25:13-22. What stands out for you in the way that Festus describes the charges against Paul?
4. Read Acts 26:12-18. Compare this with Acts 9:1-19. What new details emerge for you? Why might they be important?
