 - a. Formerly (4:8)
 - b. Now (4:9a)
 - c. Again (4:9b-11)
2. Then Paul applies this same argument to his life in 4:12-20. What does he say about himself?
 - a. At first (4:12-16)
 - b. Now (4:17)
 - c. Again (4:19-20)
3. What does it mean that the story of Hagar and Sarah (4:22-28) is an allegory? What does Paul have to say about ...?
 - a. Once (4:22-23)
 - b. Now (4:24-27)
 - c. Again (4:28)
4. Paul concludes the discussion by saying *what* about ...?
 - a. Once (4:29a)
 - b. Now (4:29b-30)
 - c. Again (4:31-5:1)
