NE MN Synod Lay Leader Network: Yearly Intensive Series

Here is an exciting opportunity coming up this September 2019 through May of 2020. Bethlehem will be one of two host sites for the yearly intensive series that is specifically geared for lay leaders in congregations. The cost is \$220 which covers all four sessions (Saturdays: Sep. 7, Nov. 16, Feb. 15, May 16) from 9 am – 4 pm. The Bethlehem Endowment board is providing a \$55 discount for the first 12 Bethlehem members that register. Dr. Jim Bailey, New Testament Emeritus at Concordia College and Wartburg Theological Seminary; Rev. Dr. Dave Mesner, Senior Pastor at Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd in Duluth, and Rev. As a life-long learning program, the Yearly Intensive Series is designed to give adult students an opportunity to grow in their faith for the purposes of personal spiritual development, biblical and theological learning and enhancing missional leadership. It promotes intentional conversation for the discernment of gifts to be used in various ways in ministry and leadership within a person's current congregation and in his/her community.

YEARLY INTENSIVE SERIES "at a Glance"

Each program year comprises four day-long seminars led by accomplished Synod theologians, various assigned readings and tasks, opportunities to engage in group learning between seminars, and exercises for the encouragement of individual discernment and spiritual growth, and skills enhancement.

Content includes: Biblical Study/Lutheran Theology (35%); Leadership and Spiritual Development (30%); Engaging Missional Context (20%); Specific Ministry Focus (15%)

The Yearly Intensive Series' biblical study content aligns with the ELCA lectionary, encouraging new students to enter the three-year program cycle at any year.

The plan for this year is to serve at eight locations four days a week. This year Bethlehem has the honor of being the host site for sandwich making. We will be serving Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday starting June 3 through the end of August. We are in need of bread, peanut butter (any kind), jam, fruit cups, granola bars, fruit snacks, individually packaged snacks, sandwich baggies, plastic spoons, and food handling gloves. If you are interested in donating to Operation Sandwich, you are welcome to bring supplies and place them on the cart at the top of the stairs by the elevator. We also accept monetary donations to help purchase fruit and veggies; please turn that into the office.

Bethlehem will be in charge of making sandwiches the week of August 19. If you want to help that week, let the office know. More information will come as it gets closer.

O It's better for the environment to wash your car by hand than at the car wash.

R Not so, reports the International Car Wash Association and the LA Times, among others. For many do-it-yourselfers, washing a car by hand means using a steady stream of water. This approach can use 100 or more gallons of water versus 15-75 used by many commercial car washes.

E Carwash businesses are required to send their dirty wash water to municipal wastewater plants for treatment. Some businesses reclaim it for re-use onsite. Water and contaminants from home vehicle washing, on the other hand, typically drain to stormwater sewers and right into rivers and other surface waters, where they pollute.

If you're committed to washing your car at home, use eco-friendly car washing strategies. Otherwise consider taking it to a commercial carwash.

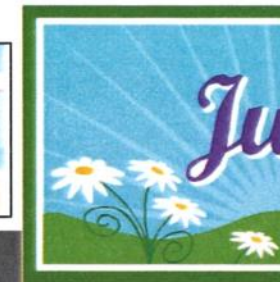
