

CREATION CARE

We all have to eat. Farmer/author/poet Wendell Berry writes that "eating is an agricultural act," which makes our reliance on agricultural methods that disregard soil and eco-

system health a danger to us and all the living things on whose well-being we depend. The Nature Conservancy (TNC) reports that as complex grasslands continue to be converted to single crops, the loss of biodiversity has accelerated. From 1970 to 2016 there was a nearly **70% average decline in populations of birds, beneficial insects, amphibians, mammals, fish and reptiles.** The intensive use of agro-chemicals, such as **synthetic nitrogen, herbicides, pesticides and fungicides** make their way into the food we eat, the water we drink, and the air we breathe. **Children are the most vulnerable,** be-

cause pound for pound, they drink **2.5 times** more water, eat **3 - 4 times** more food, breathe **2 times** more air, and therefore absorb a higher concentration of pesticides than adults. Support efforts to fix our broken food system, which include **renewable energy**, **regenerative agriculture that replaces or mitigates big, single-crop agriculture, restora**-

tion of forests, grasslands, wetlands, and habitat that supports pollinators.




