#### From the Senior Pastor

Grace and peace be with you,

I am so proud of the good work that our Bethlehem leaders and staff continue to do throughout this COVID-19 pandemic: from our technical team that makes the weekly live-stream worship possible, to our faithful custodians that keep our building clean and sanitized, to our board leaders and so many others. I know that we are yearning to re-

turn to gathering together in our building for worship and for celebrating holy communion, and we will, hopefully soon, but I think we need to understand that it is probably going to look different for a while. For now, hopefully you can join us on Facebook for the live stream of our Sunday morning service at 10:30 am or our Wednesday evening fireside devotional at 6:20 pm. You may also visit our website anytime and view the morning service. I have included a message from our NE MN Synod Bishop Tom Aitken below. I am thankful for his faithful service to our church and our partner congregations throughout our Synod.

Please look for a letter later this month from the Board of Worship and Music regarding worship practices.

Dear beloved members of the Northeastern Minnesota Synod,

Grace and peace to you in Christ our brother and Lord.

Martin Luther's writings have been "gold" for me lately:

"Since God has given me in Christ all the riches of righteousness and salvation so that from now on I need nothing except faith, why should I not therefore freely, with all my heart do all things pleasing to God who has overwhelmed me with irresistible riches? .......... I will therefore give myself as a Christ to my neighbor and do nothing in this life except what is necessary, profitable, and salutary for my neighbor." (From "The Freedom of the Christian" 1520)

I am strongly recommending that no worship or other in-person gatherings take place in our church buildings throughout the month of May, at the very least. I urge us instead, to focus on what Luther learned from Scripture and preached during widespread sickness in his day: live out your faith by serving your neighbor. Our neighbor is everyone. Serving as Christ to our neighbor right now is slowing the pandemic we all live in these days. Make no mistake, the COVID-19 pandemic will be with us yet for a long time, beyond the summer months, into the fall, and beyond. It is vital that we be mature Christians here, and pay attention to the world as it is and keep on slowing the virus spread, in spite of our deep desire to gather with others "like we used to." Martin Luther, once again: "Behold, from faith flows love that serves one's neighbor and takes no account of gratitude or ingratitude, praise or blame, gain or loss. We do not distinguish friends from enemies because God's love makes us free." (Freedom of the Christian)

#### CREATION CARE

While Minnesota lacks fossil fuels, we have plenty of wind and sun to replace coal and oil trains and related pollution. The state has cut emissions from the power sector by a third since 2005, and by 12% overall in the decade through 2015, according to Bloomberg New Energy Finance and the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency. Public opinion, most states, and an increasing number of businesses are embracing the need to address climate change by greening the economy, finding significant costs savings as well as "explosive growth" in clean energy and energy efficient businesses. Since 2009, the cost of solar energy has dropped by 80% and wind by about 65%, while coal, the dirtiest fossil fuel, has declined from about two-thirds to 40% of the state's electricity generation.



# **Operation Sandwich Update**


Operation Sandwich is back up and running since the schools closed six weeks ago. We have been handing out weekly meal packs in collaboration with Sharing Bread Soup Kitchen on Thursday evenings. In addition to the public distribution, we also have been working with many of our community partners to get meals to them. The community partners that we have been working weekly include Lutheran Social Services Teen Services, Lutheran Social Services Transitional Living, the collaborative workers from the schools, Crow Wing County, and the Shop.

Moving towards summer, much like everyone else, we are waiting to see how things play out as to what exactly Operation Sandwich will be doing in the summer months. We are waiting to see how Minnesota opens a bit as well as what our school district decides to do. We have had some conversations about doing weekly lunch packs that families would pick up to minimize people having to go out and about and collaborate.

We are hoping we get to a place where we can have lots of volunteers and people dropping off actual items again.
