

Description of Picking Areas

NOTES: • Below areas are focused on littering “hot-spots” – they are not exhaustive – feel free to chop and change.

- The intent is each area can be covered by up to but not limited to 2 people within 2 hours, assuming an average amount of litter. It is not exact.
- If littering is heavy in an area, Val may allocate one area to more than one team. Please work together in this case.

Where possible the walks are circular often starting by a bin so that you walk the lighter part of the route allowing your bag to get heavier as you return to the bin. but **You are free to alter away from the suggested walks.**

Pick Boundaries	Suggested route if time permits other roads/ footpaths could be picked.
1.Church to entrance of Firs Chase caravan park just off the sea wall beyond the Dabchicks Sailing club	S&F Victory. Carpark picker 1 turns right & picks to the Firs Chase Caravan Site including carparks & back. Person 2 turns left & picks to Church Rd & back via Monkey Steps, St Peters well, greensward, Board Walk to Victory.
2. From Victory carpark to Highstreet North and back via Firs chase.	Start Victory carpark. Up Victory road, to High Street North & left again into Firs Road, T left down Firs Chase, to The Lane, along to the Dinghy Park, along past Yacht club, up the other section of Firs Chase Rosebank Road, Victory Road & back to Victory.
3A. Area bounded by Barfield rd. Kingsland rd. Upland Road & lower part of High Street North	S&F Legion carpark. Pick to Tesco, High St North, Upland Rd. School Gardens / Skate Park, Loop.
3B Area bounded by Yorick Road, High Street, Barfield Road and Lower Kingsland Road.	Park Legion along Lower Kingsland to beach back to X rds up Yorick rd, War Memorial back to Library carpark along High Street to Tesco (assuming route 3A is covered) but not pick the carpark return & pick Legion Carpark.
4.Area bounded by Garden Farm Flats and surrounding roads and footpaths.	Park at very top of Oakwood Avenue which continues almost to the entrance to the Glebe via short foot path. Saturday parking at the Glebe is a nightmare. Pick the Glebe Car park, Garden Farm and the Flats carparks and if time permits footpath Windsor rd. to Mill Rd.

5. Area bounded by Empress Avenue, Victoria Esplanade, Seaview Avenue and East Road.	Park in any of the Avenues. The Avenues, including Seaview Car Park and Esplanade Car Park
6. Dawes Lane, East Mersea Road, Strood, Wellhouse Hill to the Glebe.	Park top Oakwood avenue, footpath to Glebe, take the foot path in the very far right-hand corner of the playing field. Then left to past the newly planted woodland to get on to the footpath that leads to the middle of Dawes lane. East Mersea rd down to the strood back to Wellhouse Hill Loop to your car. <u>Danger from close fast passing traffic.</u>
7. Area Bounded by Dawes Lane, East Mersea Road to Blue Row, Chapmans Lane and East Road.	Park in Dawes Lane and walk towards East Mersea Road when you to get near to the long wooden and concrete posted fence take the foot path leading to Blue Row, Chapmans Lane to entrance road of Waldegraves Caravan Park down to actual park gates and return to East Road back to your car in Dawes Lane.
8A. The Beach from Broomhills to the Boardwalk & back	Park in Prince Albert road near The Coverts. Pick Beach by Broomhills / Esplanade junction to Boardwalk and back.
8B. Beach from Bottom of Seaview Avenue to Broomhills including carparks.	Beach and Seaview, Willoughby & Esplanade carparks - including Victoria Esplanade, Please work with teams covering Area 5.
8C. Beach from Bottom Seaview Avenue to Waldegraves Caravan site.	Park in any of the Avenues. Beach and surrounding areas from end of Seaview beach huts to Waldegraves caravan site, Includes grassed area and wooded area. Behind the beach
9. East Mersea	Park by East Mersea village hall. Walk Left onto East Mersea Road to Old Golf club free small carpark and back.
10 East Mersea to Blue Row	Park at East Mersea Village hall. Pick to Blue Row and Back.
11 Broman's Lane and Country Park	Broman's lane and Cudmore Grove.
12. East Mersea point	Park at free small carpark near old golf club. East Mersea Car Park, path and Beach around Stone Point.
13. Oakwood Avenue and surrounding Roads	Oakwood Avenue and surrounding Roads
14. Chatsworth Rd surrounding roads and Reymead Close	Chatsworth Rd surrounding area, and Reymead Close
