Away Game Dinner Crew

This is a group of parents/friends who work together to provide a simple but nutritious meal to our Marching Band students before each Away Game. Since Away games have an earlier Call Time, some students do not even go home and most do not have time to eat dinner- this is the purpose of this Crew. There are 5 Away games during the season plus any playoff games- this Crew meets to plan the season's meals and then arrives at the school with the food to set up and feed the students usually around 3:30pm or 4pm and this lasts about 1 hour each time.

3rd Quarter Snack Crew

This is a group of parents/friends who work together to provide a simple but nutritious snack to our Marching Band students during the 3rd quarter of every game. This group will be providing the snacks, but is not the same as the game chaperones **so your commitment is not to be at the games, simply to bring the snacks to the school each Friday**. There are 10 games during the season plus any playoff games.

There will be a list of acceptable snacks provided to this team and this will also include the preparing of Hot Chocolate once the season turns cold.

Dessert Crew

This is a group of parents/friends who are the go-to for various events to provide desserts/refreshments.

This crew is on-call and would be the list we start with when an event is up-coming.

There would be plenty of notice and desserts can be homemade or store-bought (we don't judge!)

Tag Day Crew

Tag Day is the Music Program's largest fundraiser of the year.

This Crew will meet once prior to stuff envelopes, prepare routes and plan the day. (approx. 2 hours)

On event day, **September 29, 2018**, this crew will serve as drivers and organizers. (The event lasts approximately 7 hours, but is split up into 2 shifts)

Many Many Many Hands will be required to make this important event a success! **Please consider joining this crew for, essentially, a one-day commitment that will make an enormous difference in our program!**

Uniform Crew

This is a group of parents/friends who work together to ensure that our students' uniforms fit, are in good condition, are clean and are available.

A large part of this Crew is the fittings that are performed during Band Camp- and we have a small crew already available to do that, but if you are available for that, please sign up.

Another large part of this Crew is being in the Band room for about 1 hour prior to each game to help the students with any uniform needs. This role can vary from helping a student find his hat, to helping them button the jacket, to spot cleaning a pair of shoes.

Aside from those responsibilities, the Directors will call on members of this crew as needed for things like mending, picking up/delivering uniforms to/from dry cleaners, and placing orders for new uniforms.
