Music Scholarship	 Music Boosters has traditionally offered up to two \$500 scholarships to Seniors in a Kirtland Music Program who are committed to attending college and majoring in Music. There have not been any students meeting these criteria in a few years. This year we have one- Sarah LaMantia- Band student attending Miami University to major in Music Education VOTE: Do we offer the scholarship this year? VOTE: If we offer the scholarship, do we keep it at \$500 or raise it due to the rising cost of education and the fact that it does not happen often? (\$750? \$1,000?) VOTE: If we offer the scholarship, do we create an application and have Sarah formally apply?
Sousaphone update	 2 of the 6 are completed and paid for Mr D is in touch with the repair shop. Goal is to have all 6 completed before Band Camp (July 20th) but the entire staff of the shop is furloughed at this time. The owner is working on them.
Spirit Wear Store	VOTE: Since we cannot do much of anything else, do we want to have an online Spirit Wear store? Vector is able to do this and we can add ship-direct option (UPS shipping rates that depend on the size of the order)
Kiwanis Collaboration for Graduating Seniors Update	 A few weeks ago, Kiwanis approached the Board asking if we were interested in a collaboration to provide a recognition to the graduating Seniors. The Board discussed and voted to contribute up to \$500 on this project. Kiwanis are managing this project and have not yet provided us with an update on what the recognition gift or final cost will be.
Financial Update	Carrie to provide our savings accounts' numbers to date
Effects of Covid-19	 As of right now, we are working under the assumption that all summer and fall activities will happen as planned- so Band Camp, Marching Band etc are "as scheduled" until we learn otherwise from the school. As of right now, only Vickie has permission to enter the Concession Stand. All school-owned buildings are closed except when authorized by the building admin (Amstutz).
Effects of the State Budget cuts on Music Boosters	 State cut \$362,000 from Kirtland Local School District Direct effects on the Music Program is a \$1000 cut to the Repair Budget and a \$1000 cut to the Curricula Budget We need to be prepared to reevaluate the funds that we earmarked this year to help in other areas- while still working hard to stay in our scope of being here to augment the music program.
Bottom Line	There will be changes when school resumes so all areas of our fundraising will be affected

	(Concession Stand, Tag Day etc) But we cannot solve a problem when we don't even truly know what the problem is yet. Brainstorm, write ideas down, think outside the box- we will come together when we know more.
