	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Boosters to pay for raffles prizes (did this traditionally already- will just look different to the students as to how they win prizes)
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No need for traditional expenses like Gatorade, cups, snacks, washcloths etc
Marching Band Uniforms	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Summer Uniforms and some version of that for colder weather will be worn <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Everyone will wear their polo (9th graders will wear their middle school one) Mr D should have enough K shorts in storage for the incoming 9th graders No shoe orders
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Therefore, no use of our actual Marching Band uniforms this year and they will not have to be cleaned again
Raincoats	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Premier still has 25 raincoats since Dec 2019. Said the waterproofing is out of stock and they are waiting on it to come in.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> May need these for rain or colder weather late in the season
Concession stand & 50/50	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Still no overturn of the "no spectators" rule so we have no idea if there will be people in the stands, or how many there will be if they are allowed
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There is talk of "no cash" as a Kirtland rule. I told Admin that will harm us at the concession stand and to please keep us up to date <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If no cash rule goes in, we need to look at using the card reader for concession stand If no cash rule goes in, we will not have a 50/50
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We now own 4 plexiglass counter stands (sneeze guards) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> One line at each window with 1 volunteer working at each window- nobody else in the concession stand (2 sneeze guards) One table near entrance selling 50/50 tickets- 1 person (1 sneeze guard) One table near visitor entrance selling 50/50 tickets- 1 person (1 sneeze guard)

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I am creating a volunteer sign-off sheet that all volunteers will be required to read/sign before helping- it is the same questions that are asked of the participants before every event and will include temperatures being taken.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Everyone must be masked at all times
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We must keep a detailed list of all volunteers, where they were, what they were doing
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In total we will only need 4-5 volunteers each game
Away Games	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bands will not be travelling to Away games so no dinners, chaperones, cups, snacks, drinks, hot coco etc will be needed
Fall Program	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I sent Chera our ad artwork- Carrie please arrange payment to her

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The program fee Mr Soeder told us about last year has been paid in full by the school

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I was in the final round of interviews for the new part-time Choir teacher with Mr D and Mr Soeder
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Both candidates were fantastic and would bring an energy and level of learning to the role
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Admin is checking references and deciding this week
Tag Day	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Start thinking about the logistics of an online version of "Tag Day".
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I'd like to work with Sheila D. to make a video with at least a dozen different band and choir students speaking about "Why is the Kirtland Music Program Important to me?"
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We can spread the video on social media and even ask if the local papers/organizations would put it out as well (think Kiwanis, Police Dept, local politicians etc) for a further audience.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We can take a full-page ad in the Chronical with some student pics/quotes and ask the community to give electronically since we cannot go door-to-door this year
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will meet about this after school/season begins
Boosters website/Social Media	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I will meet separately with Jen Reilly to teach her how to update the website and make sure she has access to the social media pages etc
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reminder that we cannot use our Boosters Social Media to make announcements that should come from Mr D. As things are changing fast, this will become even more important.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> People will come to us, as representatives of the Band and ask questions, updates, opinions... please refer them to Mr D always. Again, things change and even if we think we know the answer, it might be different.
Reminder- we are representatives of this group at all times	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please remember that we are always representing the school and this program and even if we don't agree with final decisions we should act as representatives at all times.
