There are <u>three possible membership levels</u> offered on the Texas A&M IHSA Equestrian Team: Competitive, Non-Competitive, and Social. We group these membership levels into <u>two tiers:</u> <u>Competition and Social</u>.

Social Tier:

Prospects who select the social tier are <u>not required to try out</u> but are **REQUIRED** to complete an interview to be considered for membership. This option is great for those who want to be involved with the team but cannot commit to the requirements for competition tier membership.

Competition Tier:

Prospects who select the competition tier are **REQUIRED** to try out and **REQUIRED** to complete an interview to be considered for membership. This option is for those who want to be eligible for the show roster. <u>Competition tier members will be designated a</u> <u>"Competitive" or "Non-Competitive" status after the first scrimmage.</u> Competitive members will be picked first for the show roster, but Non-Competitive members could be picked to show if a spot in their division is available. <u>Keep in mind that these statuses are fluid, and members can be moved from Competitive to Non-Competitive or Non-Competitive at any point during the season.</u>
