

ABA4U is looking to hire RBTs for full time within the clinic. Hours are Monday-Friday 8:45am-roughly 3:00/15. We provide training for RBT and supervision hours for RBT, BCaBA, and BCBA. Right now just phone interviews are conducted for this position. Potential home case hours after the clinic hours are also available (we are not hiring just for home hours, but it is an additional piece).

Registered Behavior Technician (RBT)

Registered Behavior Technicians are responsible for conducting sessions. They will follow the programs and guidelines presented by the program coordinator and the BCBA supervisor. This includes per opportunity response based data collection on skill acquisition, behavior reduction, inter-observer agreement, and generalization. Registered Behavior Technicians are required to have a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree in a related field and have undergone specialized training in the field of ABA.

The RBT's responsibilities include:

Session setup (conducted 15 minutes prior to your patient's session) and clean up after session. Listed below is a list of some of the items to be completed pre and post session.

Pre-Session:

- Print out data sheets
- Clinic data sheets: Primary data collector, parent, and IOA data collector
- Home data sheet
- Environmental arrangement (e.g. furniture setup toys/materials)
- Motivational system: reinforcers, token board etc.
- Video camera setup

Post- Session:

- Edit data sheet as necessary
- Graph data (paper, pencil, ruler)
- Collect IOA
- Formulate a list of questions/concerns to be discussed at your scheduled supervision meeting
