

## Jabroczy family in Slovakia and beyond.

According available baptism church records the oldest occurrence of Jabroczy family name is in town of Kežmarok in Northern Slovakia (Spiš region).

Hungarian historian Iván NAGY writes about Jábróczy family in his book *Magyarország családai czímerekkel és nemzedékrendi táblákkal*. (*Families of Hungary with coats of arms and genealogical tables*.) Budapest, 1857-1868. p. 273:

The Jábróczy family comes from Dalmatia, who came to Spiš from there. The son of Luis Jábróczy, Benedikt, received a noble title and coat of arms from king Sigismund in Bratislava in 1411 (in festo ded. S. Michaelis Archangeli - 29 September 1411) for his merits. Benedikt's brother Albert was captain of the king's personal guard. He fought with the king at Nikopol and fell there. Benedikt was captured and suffered in captivity together with the king in Siklós castle. His descendants lived in Kežmarok in Spiš before 1600.

Adam the Elder was in 1601 the court captain of Stephan \*1581 - †1651 (possibly also Sebastian \*? - †1607) Tököly and is mentioned in a document of Rudolf II, according to which he is obliged to pay 2,000 florins to Pethö of Gerse as compensation for the injury of Francis Pethö. According to the aforementioned documents, Adam the Elder had three sons, Daniel, Adam and Job. In 1681, Adam the Elder was beheaded by the Tököly family.

The coat of arms of the family is, according to the description in the coat of arms, divided horizontally into two halves, the lower one is golden, the upper one is silver; From the lower half, a blood-red rock rises like a pyramid to the silver half, and on it a pelican is seen sitting in a nest with outstretched wings, feeding its three young with blood from its breast. Above the halves are two helmets with a visor, of which a double cross stained with blood is depicted on the crown of the right one, and from the left crown a naturally coloured two-tailed lion emerges, which holds the severed head of a Turk in its right forepaw and a bloody halberd in its left. The coat of arms is depicted and also described in the supplement to Siebmacher's Wappenbuch catalogue.

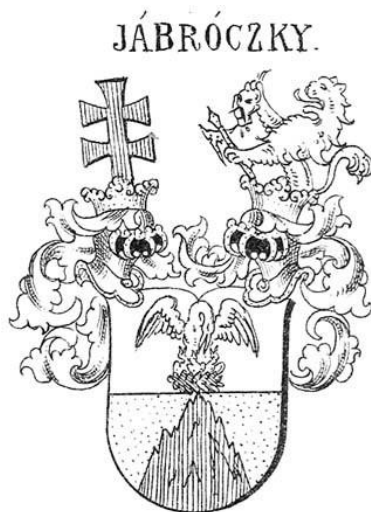


Fig 1. Jábróczy coat of arms

While researching the available documents in the Evangelic a. v. church registry of those born in Kežmarok, two Jabroczy brothers were found: Daniel \*1624 and Adam \*1627. Their father was Adam Jabroczy and Daniel's mother was Barbora.

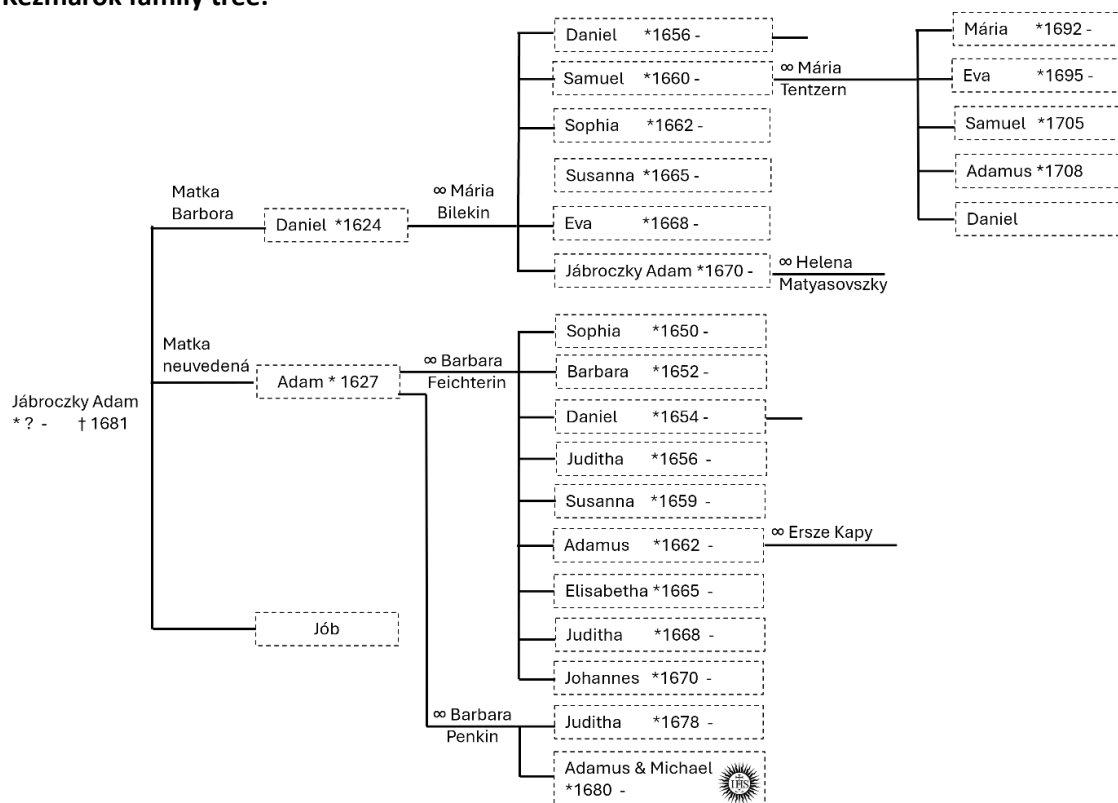

Jób Jábroczy was not found in the church birth register.

Records have been preserved about some members of the Jábroczy family, describing events in their lives:

Samuel Jabroczy is listed as Civis Nobilis in the census of the free royal city of Kežmarok in 1715 and 1720.

Michael and Adam Jabroczy \* 1680 (1683) studied in Košice catholic gymnasium and later became members of Jesuits order. They were in probation in Trenčín. Adam Jabroczy worked as notarius in Jasov premonstrate monastery.

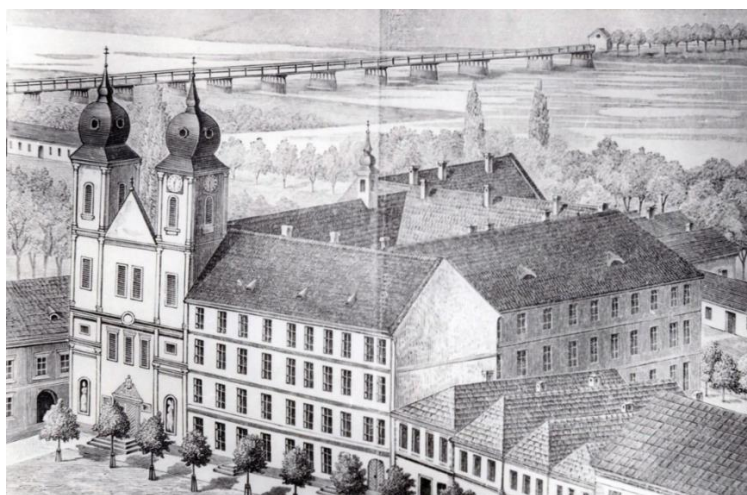


Fig. 3 Jesuit gymnasium in Trenčín. Source: Trenčianske múzeum in Trenčín.

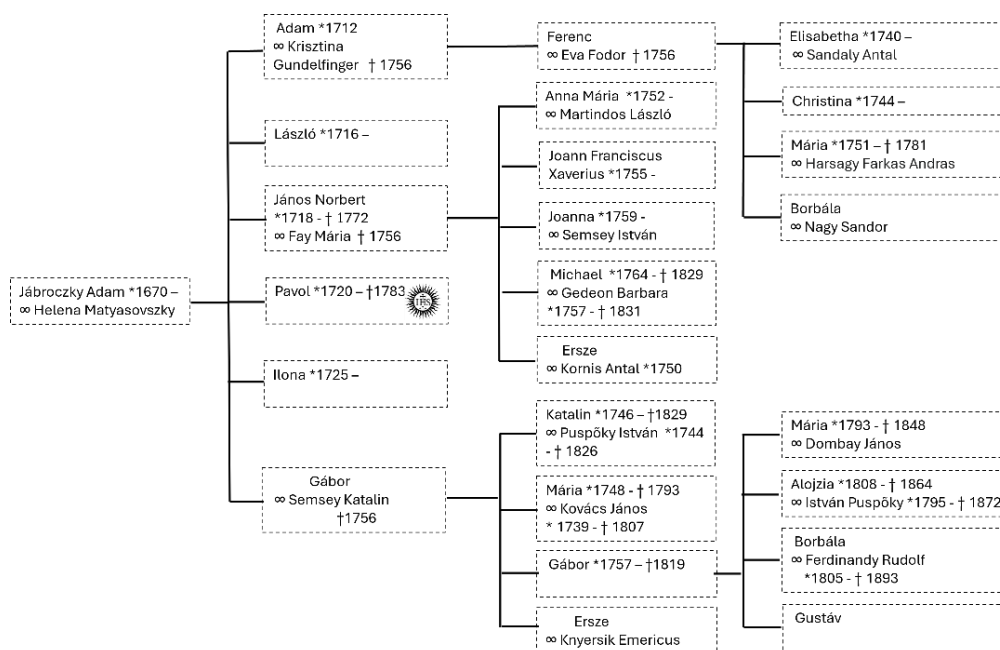


Fig. 4 Coat of arms of Adam Jabroczy from 1744.

Adam Jabroczy \*1670 with Helena Matyasovszky founded his branch in Košice:



From this branch following persons became significant:

**János Norbert Jabroczy** \*1718 was in 1761 - 1774 the deputy director for legal affairs of the Spiš Chamber (Causarum Regalium vicedirector) in Košice. Gábor (I.), husband of Katarína Semsey, was in 1793 - 1798 the school inspector in the Košice school district and his son Gábor (II.) \*1757 - †1819 was a judge in 1800.

**Pavol Jabroczy** \*1720 in Veľká Ida. He became jesuit and during his career he became a teacher poet and superior of jesuit house in Sárospatak until the jesuit order was abolished by the pope in 1773.



**Andreas Jabroczyk**, \*1749 in Bernátovce (part of Valaliky village). In 1759–1765 he studied at the Catholic gymnasium school in Košice. He joined the Society of Jesus in 1766 in Košice. In 1767 he was a novice and scholastic in the probation house in Trenčín and at the same time a first-year student of philosophy. In 1769 he worked in Skalica, in 1771–1772 in Trnava. After the abolition of the Jesuit order, he was appointed professor of grammar at the college in Košice by decree of Maria Theresa in 1773. Andreas Jabroczyk is mentioned in 1784 in the charter of Joseph II. granting the privileges of the market town of Veľká Ida and permission to hold fairs.

Several members of the Jabroczyk family studied at the then higher schools. They are mentioned as students of the Levoča College. Students with the surname Jabroczyk/Jabroccki who studied at the Košice Gymnasium and the University of Košice are listed in Tables 3 and 4:

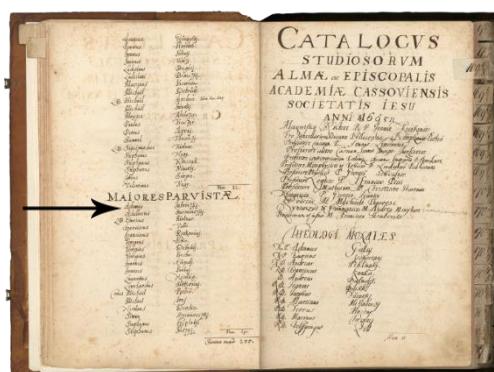


Fig. 7 Register of the University of Košice, year 1695. Adam Jabroczyk registered as a parvist in the year 1694. Source: Košice City Archives.

According to Iván Nagy, Adam Jabroczy moved to Transylvania, where he married the noblewoman Erszébet Kapy. His son Gábor asked the crown to renew the coat of arms.

He received the new coat of arms in a document of Leopold I in 1700. In the copy of the document from the monastery in Kolozsvár from 6 Dec 1721, their other family relationships are listed: Applicant - Gábor, son of Ádám Jabroczy of Jabrod - senior, Erszébet Kapy - mother, Gábor Kapy - grandfather, Ezsébet Mindszenti - grandmother, Dániel Jabroczy of Jabrod - brother of Adam senior.

The family tree of Adam Jabroczy and Erszébet Kapy according to Iván Nagy, transylvanian historian József Kádár and church registers is in Table 5.

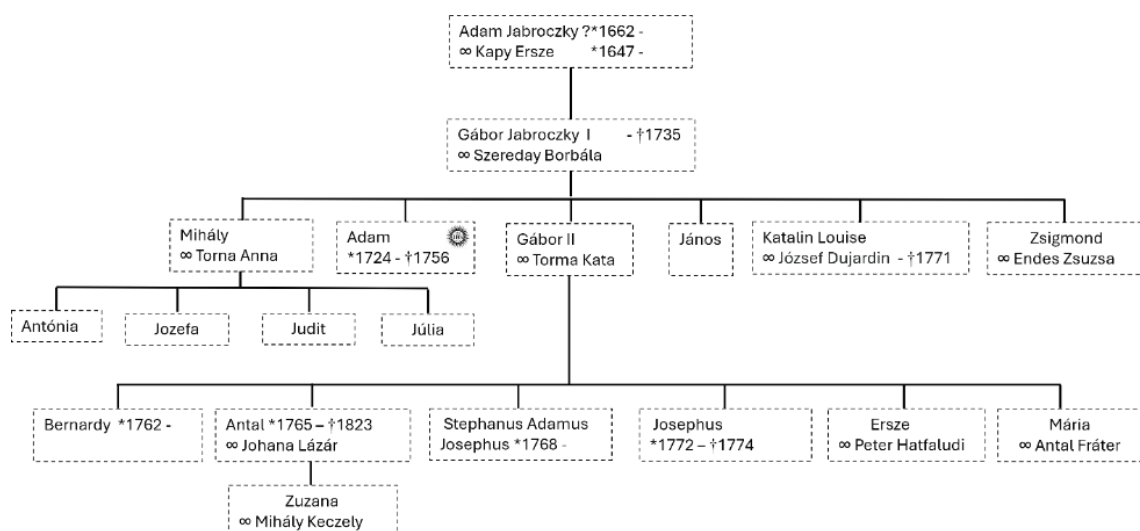

From this branch following persons became significant:

**Adam Jabroczy**, \*1724 in Vice in Transylvania. In 1739 he studied in Kolozsvár, where he joined the Jesuit order, in 1740 - 1741 he studied at the gymnasium in Trenčín, in 1742 in Skalica, in 1743 - 1745 philosophy in Vienna, in 1746 in Bratislava. In 1747 - 1748 he taught in Kolozsvár, in 1749 at the college in Eger. In 1750 - 1753 he studied theology in Vienna, in 1754 - 1755 he worked at the college in Banská Bystrica and as a missionary in Šahy. In 1756, he was a missionary in Transylvania, where he died during an epidemic in the same year.

Ivan Nagy described fortunes of some other members of this Jabroczy branch, but their relevancy is difficult to prove by now.



Now then we fully described the fortunes of Jabroczy family members originated from Adam Jabroczy from Kežmarok, let us study possible offsprings back in Spiš region.

The oldest occurrence of family Jábroczy out of Kežmakok is found in Stará Ľubovňa (Lubla) in 1712.

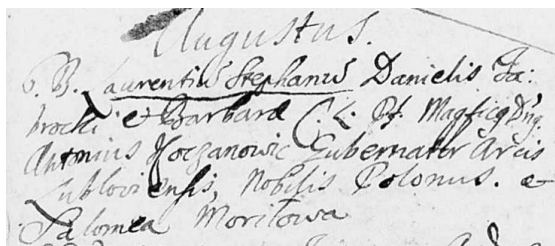


Fig. 12 Detail of the entry in the baptismal register in St. Ľubovňa 6 Aug 1712 Laurentio Stephanus Jabrocki, father Daniel, mother Barbara. Source: FamilySearch®.

In the literature dealing with the history of the Reformation and Counter-Reformation movements and the Tököly uprising, three men with the surname Jabroczyk are mentioned in Spiš. One of them, Daniel Jabroczyk, could have been the father of Laurentius Stephanus Jabrocki. BRUCKNER Győző in his book “History of the Reformation and Counter-Reformation in Spiš Region (1520 – 1745) vol. I. - A reformáció és ellenreformáció története a Szepességben. I. kötet (1520–1745-ig). Budapest 1922. p. 450” describes how in 1710 captains Gottlob and Jabroczyk captured the envoys of 13 Spiš towns sent to the Polish king Augustus II. with a complaint against Teodor Konstantin Lubomirský for not respecting the rights of free choice of their religion given by the king.

The envoys were captured and taken to Lublo (Stará Ľubovňa). At that time, Stará Ľubovňa was under the administration of the Polish king based on the pledge agreement of Sigismund of Luxembourg from 1412, together with 34 Spiš towns and villages (Spiš Pledge 1412-1773). Stará Ľubovňa was under the command of T. K. Lubomirsky, the last mayor of the Province of 13 Spiš towns (1702—1745) from the princely family of Lubomirsky, captain of Lublin Castle, son of Stanislav Heraklion Lubomirsky. The Polish king August II. learned about the imprisonment of the envoys and ordered their release. Despite this, T. K. Lubomirsky released them only in 1712.

Further on no direct connections between Laurentio Stephanus Jabrocki and other Jabrocky family members in Stará Ľubovňa were found.

First Jabroczyk family branch continued thru centuries is family of Franciscus Jabroczyk and Rosalia.

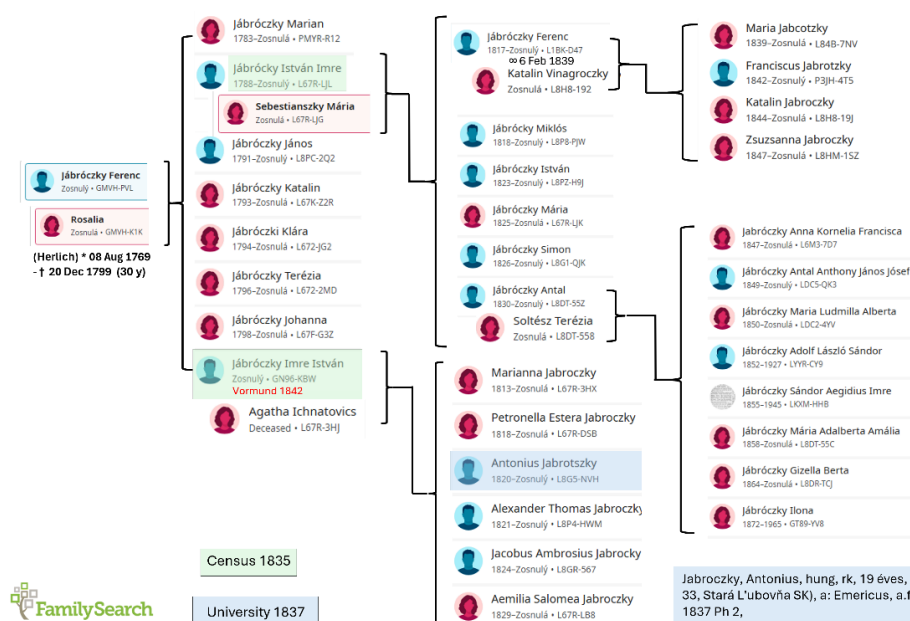


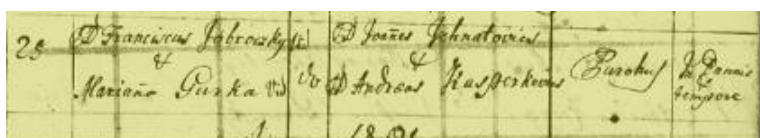
Fig. 15 Family relationships between members of the Jabroczy family (Ferenc and Rosalia and their descendants) in Stará Ľubovňa, mentioned in addition to the registry, in the census and in the registry of the University of Košice. Source: Author's archive.

In the Collection of Lists of Noble Families of Spiš County. Part III. Census of 1835, the nobles Franz. Jabroczyk, Joseph. Jabroczyk, Emericus (Imrich) Jabroczyk and Stephanus Jabroczyk are listed in Stará Ľubovňa (Vetus Lubló).

In the Almanac of Trade and Crafts (Handels- und Gewerbs-Almanach) from 1842, Imrich (Emerich) Jabroczyk is listed in the town administration of Stará Ľubovňa (Lublau) as a vormund (legal representative of citizens).

Wife of Franciscus Jabroczyk Rosalia dies 20 Dec 1799 aged 30. Franciscus Jabroczyk then marries Marianna Gurka \* 1769 in Stará Ľubovňa on 25 Oct 1800 establishing second branch of Jabroczyk family in Stará Ľubovňa.

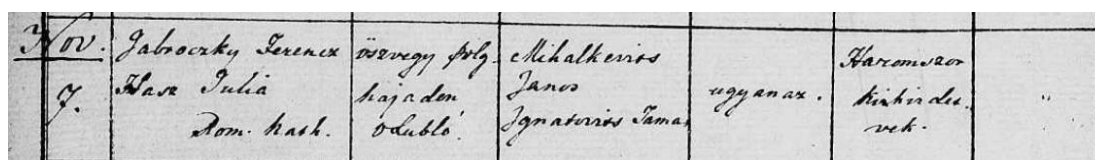

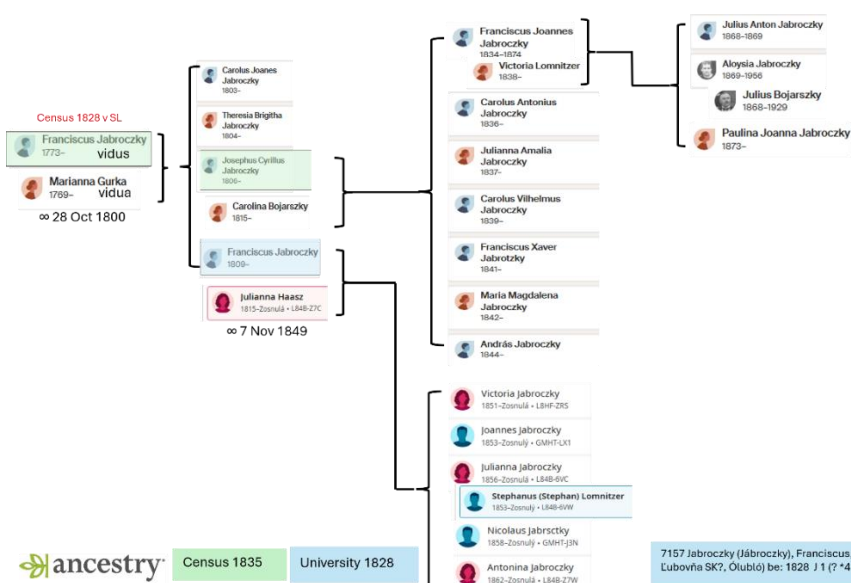


Fig. 16 Family relationships between members of the Jabroczyk family (Franciscus and Marianna and their descendants) in Stará Ľubovňa, mentioned in addition to the registry, in the census and in the registry of the University of Košice. Source: Author's archive.

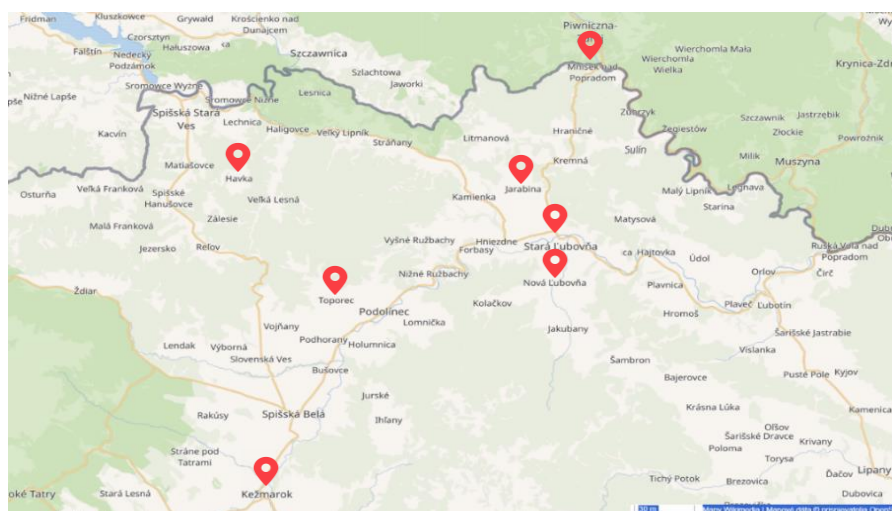
