

INDIGENOUS PEOPLES OF MEXICO ARE THOSE WHO ARE PART OF COMMUNITIES THAT TRACE THEIR ROOTS BACK TO POPULATIONS AND COMMUNITIES THAT EXISTED IN WHAT IS NOW MEXICO PRIOR TO THE ARRIVAL OF EUROPEANS, AND WHOM PRESERVE THEIR OWN SOCIAL, ECONOMIC, CULTURAL AND POLITICAL INSTITUTIONS, OR PART OF THEM.

THE MEXICAN CONSTITUTION RECOGNIZES AND GUARANTEES THE RIGHT OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLES AND COMMUNITIES TO SELF-DETERMINATION AND, CONSEQUENTLY, AUTONOMY TO: I. DECIDE THEIR INTERNAL FORMS OF COEXISTENCE AND SOCIAL, ECONOMIC, POLITICAL AND CULTURAL ORGANIZATION. IN 2015, 25,694,928 PEOPLE IN MEXICO SELF-IDENTIFY AS BEING INDIGENOUS




