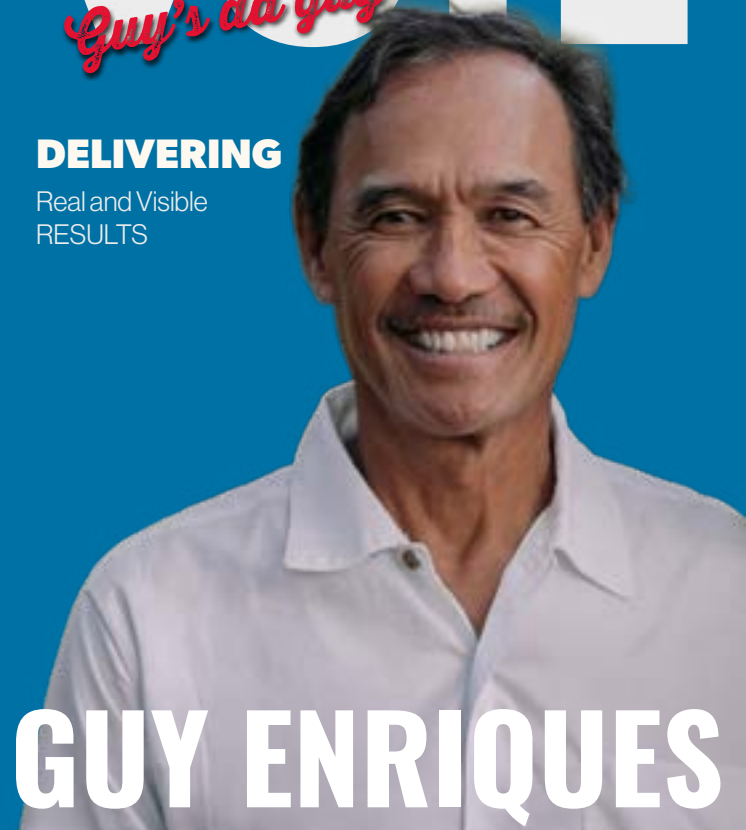

- \$18.9 million dollar Hurricane Shelter and Gymnasium in Pāhala (State/County)
- \$500,000 budget to drill well for potable water in Ocean View (DPW)
- Leased County Park & Ride on Prince Kuhio Blvd (P&R)
- Paved gravel parking lot at Cooper Center in Volcano (P&R)
- Extended the Cooper Center for Farmer's Market (P&R)
- Paved Ka'alaiki Road - Nā'ālehu-Pāhala emergency connector road (DPW)
- Highway repair for South Kona (DPW)
- \$62,000 to renovate Honaunau Rodeo Arena (P&R)

MAJOR PROJECTS

SOUTH KONA:

- Build a Billy Kenoi Covered Outdoor Playcourt in Kealakekua, at Clarence Won Lum County Park
- County water spigots moved for safety from Ho'okena intersection
- Resurface Greenwell Park

MILOLI'I:

- Secure area for Trash Bins

OCEAN VIEW:

- Full Service Police Station in Ocean View
- Animal shelter in Ocean View
- Speed bumps on Hyw 11 between two intersections of Prince Kuhio Blvd and Lotus Blossom Ln.
- Encourage more commerce: Bank, Pharmacy, Urgent care

DISCOVERY HARBOR:

- Improve Kamaoa road

NĀ'ĀLEHU:

- Install Ball Park Lights
- Resurface/re-fence County Park Basketball/Tennis courts
- Research options for residents needing to pay substantial funds to connect to County Sewer

PUNALU'U:

- Protect and Preserve our Coastline
- Secure Punalu'u County Park for the people of our District
- Work to find solutions to water and sewage infrastructure
- Lifeguards working 4/10 workdays

PĀHALA:

- Install Ball Park Lights
- Install large fans in County Gym
- Resurface tennis courts and transition to pickleball courts
- Support the inclusion of a School Resource Officer (SRO - official uniform Police Officer)
- Support Pāhala Visitor Center, Fueling Station and Convenience store off Hwy 11
- Research options for residents needing to pay substantial funds to connect to County Sewer

VOLCANO:

- Generator for Cooper Center
- Upgrade County Skateboard/Recreational Facility
- Widen Old Volcano Road for pedestrian/Bike safety
- Connect water tanks to address emergency use at Cooper Center
- Speed bumps on key roadways
