Date	Location	Address
5/16	Green Lake	7201 E Green Lake Dr N, Seattle
Green Lake is a 2.8 mile flat, paved trail around Green Lake. Park and meet at the Small Craft Center at the south end of the lake: GREENLAKE-MAP.jpg (1296x756)		
6/20	Soos Creek Trail	Intersection of 148 th Ave SE and SE 266 th St, Kent
Soos Creek trail is in the Kent East Hill area, featuring gentle hills, forests and wetlands. It is mostly flat and paved.		
7/18	Spanaway Park	14905 Bresemann Blvd S, Spanaway (off Military Rd)
Spanaway Park is a mostly shaded paved trail along Spanaway Lake. The trail has gentle inclines and covered picnic areas. There may be a nominal parking fee.		
8/15	Dash Point State Park	Enter from Norpoint Way. Street (house) address at that location is 4910 Norpoint Way, Tacoma
This hike will be approximately 2 miles hike on an unpaved trail. The dirt trail has hills and is mostly uneven. It is mostly shaded. There are many trails so the hike can be shorter or longer depending on what the group is interested in.		
9/19	Cedar River Trail	Address and meet up details will be provided later.
The mostly flat, paved trail that follows the Cedar River. Near Boeing in Renton.		
10/10	Issaquah Troll Hike	301 Rainier Blvd S, Issaquah
This 0.24 mile hike takes you to the Jakob Two Trees troll. Park at the Issaquah Community Center, look for the paved trail next to the parking lot and follow it south into the woods which becomes the Rainier Trail which is ADA accessible.
