DISASTER DECLARATION BURN BAN

WHEREAS, The City of Ivanhoe, Texas, on the 21ST day of July 2023, is issuing a no outdoor burning ban effective beginning on this day at 11:00 a.m. and will continue for the next 7 days or until rescinded.

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Ivanhoe, Texas, has determined, based upon current weather conditions, that no outdoor burning shall be allowed to protect life, as well as to protect or rehabilitate property, and is necessary and hereby ordered.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF IVANHOE, TEXAS:

I. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the City of Ivanhoe, Texas, pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

II. Pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Ivanhoe, Texas.

III. Pursuant to Section 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

IV. Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, the declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Emergency Management Plan.
