I was reading an article written by Ben Simpson recently and it addressed some of the issues that churches should be aware of during a time of transition/interim. It was so good I wanted to paraphrase some of his thoughts for you as a word of encouragement.

1. God will be with Victoria Baptist Church at all times! You are not forsaken. God is with you and makes an awesome promise to you... "I will never leave your or forsake you," (Heb 13:5). Pastors will come and go, and we should be reminded of the reality that every Pastor is an interim of sorts. God knew VBC would be in this transition long before it became reality and so you should remember that God will never leave you! And the presence of God is the vitality and foundation of the church.

2. God is in control. God "works all things according to the counsel of His will"

(Eph. 1:11). This pastoral transition is not happening outside of the will of God. God is working in this season of transition according to the counsel of his will. So, the question is not, "Who is in control?" God is in control! The question is, "Will you rest in him by trusting him?"

3. **God plans good out of this transition.** Jeremiah 29:11 reminds us: "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." This time of transition might not feel the best, but God has promised that He works all things together for the good of his people (Rom 8:28). This transition is included in "all things"! Therefore, you can rest assured that good will come from it. That's how awesome God is: even those things that don't feel good are used for good. It might not be the good you have in mind, but it is good. Therefore, walk forward in faith.

4. **Ministry must go on.** Notice what the Great Commission does not say, "Go therefore and make disciples . . . if you have a pastor." The Great Commission doesn't include any conditionals. In the interim, I am thrilled that you and the lay leadership of the church have made sure ministry continues. God will honor this in ways you may not see until down the road! We are to BE the church whether in or out of the building!

5. **The church must not scatter.** I have been thrilled to watch the church grow and remain excited while remaining committed to the mission and vision of VBC. The season of an interim can easily become a time of folks scattering... but you have remained vigilant in attending and gathering together for support and encouragement of one another.

VBC...you are a blessing! Lean into it and prepare for greater things to come as God is preparing YOU and your next Pastor for His desired future! And one more thing..."God is Good! All the Time!"

Summer is here. Take this delicious salad to your next barbeque. It will be a hit!

Watermelon and Feta Salad

Dressing

2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil 3 tablespoons fresh lime juice 1/2 garlic clove, minced



¹/₄ teaspoon sea salt **Salad:**

5 cups cubed watermelon
1 cup diced English cucumber
1/4 cup thinly sliced red onion
1/3 cup crumbled feta cheese
1/3 cup torn basil leaves
1/2 jalapeño or serrano pepper, thinly sliced, optional
Sea salt and coarse pepper to taste

Directions:

Make the dressing: In a small bowl, whisk together the olive oil, lime juice, garlic and salt.

Combine watermelon, cucumber, red onion, feta cheese, basil, and jalapeño pepper in a bowl. Drizzle with dressing and toss well. Season to taste with sea salt and coarse pepper and serve. Store in air tight container in refrigerator for up to one day.
