Academic Scholarship Application

Description: The Scott Business Association will award four scholarships of \$1,000 each to a 2026 High School Graduate. Scholarships will be awarded to two graduates of **Acadiana High School** and one from **Carencro High School**. The fourth scholarship will be awarded to a graduate of another educational institution and/or home school whose parent is either an SBA Member, a business owner in the City of Scott, or a resident of Scott. The graduate must be planning to attend college or community college in the Fall of 2026. Applications must be completed in full and fulfill all requirements by **April 1, 2026**.

Application Process: Applications will be available for download on the Scott Business Association website and shared with **Acadiana High** and **Carencro High**.

- ***An official high school transcript including ACT scores and two letters of reference must be submitted with the application.***

Selection Criteria:

Applicants will be judged with equal emphasis on

1. Educational preparation of the candidate (good grades, Honors and AP courses taken, extra-curricular activities, etc.)
2. Candidate's desire to attend college
3. Community and/or civic involvement (Volunteering or participation in civic activities)
4. Financial need (paying for college will require financial assistance)
5. Content and completeness of the application

Selection Process: Winners will be selected by the Scott Business Association Scholarship Committee.

Top candidates will be selected based on their performance in the following areas:

- Completed written applications (Points deducted for partial applications)
 - Personal Essay Letter
 - Personal interview

Confidentiality: All information submitted by the applicant will be held in strict confidence by the scholarship committee, and by applying, the applicant

consents that the given information will be used for scholarship purposes only.

Scholarship Eligibility and Guidelines

1. Nominee must complete the scholarship application in full and fulfill all requirements by the deadline, **April 1, 2026**.
2. Nominee must be a Scott resident or attend school at **Acadiana High School** or **Carencro High School**, or other educational institution and/or home school whose parent is either an SBA Member, or business owner in the City of Scott, or a resident of Scott, and must be planning to attend college or community college in the Fall of 2026.
3. The scholarship is not transferable and may not be sold or used by anyone other than the applicant. If the winner cannot attend college or community college in the Fall 2026, the Scholarship Committee must be notified.
4. If selected, the winners will be asked to attend the Scott Business Association's Business After Hours in Scott on a designated day in April, 2026, and permission will be needed to post photos on social media as well as in the local newspaper.
5. The scholarship will be awarded to the selected students upon presentation of an acceptance letter from the intended university or college.
