RBC's Social Venture Partners Facilitate \$100,000 Donation to Youth and Family Center MAC Sports Foundation and The American Hellenic Foundation of St. Louis each contribute \$50.000

ST. LOUIS (November 10, 2022) – Social Venture Partners (SVP), a program of the Regional Business Council that focuses on building capacity for nonprofits that serve under resourced youth in the St. Louis region, facilitated a \$100,000 donation to Youth and Family Center (YFC) for a much-needed replacement of the organization's concrete gym floor to a new wood gym floor. SVP is one of the Regional Business Council's initiatives to increase philanthropic investment in the region.

SVP partner Pete Spanos (Vetta Sports) along with his father, Leon, are facilitating the project in conjunction with the MAC Sports Foundation and The American Hellenic Foundation of St. Louis. The donors realize the unsatisfactory conditions for youth playing sports on the facility's aging concrete floor and the need to rally support for a new wood gym floor.

The MAC Sports Foundation is leading the effort to raise the total project amount of \$200,000. The MAC Sports Foundation has already dedicated \$50,000 raised from their charity golf tournament, which has been matched by The American Hellenic Foundation of St. Louis for a total of \$100,000 raised.
