Who Can Participate

Open to all Michigan College DECA Conference student attendees. Individuals or teams (up to X members) may pitch.

Pitch Requirements

Bring:

- A **prototype** (physical, digital, or conceptual mock-up)
 - A **slide deck (5–7 slides recommended)** explaining:
 1. The **problem** your product solves and why it is needed
 2. The **target niche/market** and market size
 3. Estimated **budget and costs** to bring it to market
 4. The **manufacturing or production process** (materials, timeline, complexity)
 5. The **current status** of the project (idea, prototype, testing, etc.)
 - Be prepared to **present in 2 minutes or less**.
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Judging Criteria

Pitches will be evaluated on:

- Innovation and originality



- Clear identification of a real market need
- Feasibility of production and launch
- Financial realism
- Clarity and effectiveness of the presentation

A panel of manufacturers, entrepreneurs, and educators will serve as judges.

Awards

The **top three ideas** will be recognized during the awards program.
One selected idea will **receive \$500 in start-up funding** and follow-up support.

Intellectual Property

Participants retain full ownership of their ideas.
