

DITCH ENCLOSURE & DRIVEWAY APPROACH APPLICATION and PERMIT

Section 5571.02 of the Ohio Revised Code: Places township roads under control of the trustees and requires them to keep them in good repair, incidental to the authority granted in ORC 5571.02 goes the duty to see that roads are drained, and for this purpose tile or ditches may be installed ORC 5571.16 authorizes the board of township trustees to require any person to obtain a permit.
