


DIABETIC ALERT DOG PROGRAM

Dear Future Client,

We know when looking for a service dog there's a lot of information to be gathered. We have put together this pdf for you to get a bite more generalized information.

Diabetic alert dogs can alert 15-20 minutes before your glucose meters able to pick it up. The dogs are trained to alert when your blood sugars anything lower than 80 and higher then a 150. Each applicant is affected by diabetes differently, we take a look into your life and the impact that diabetes has. From this we are able to make a tailored training program to fit your needs. We have seen how these dogs can help prevent the occurrence of diabetic comas, bringing A1c's down and the safety they bring. This is especially important to brittle diabetics and people who can't feel their B.S change. Here's a bit of a breakdown on the training, benefits, payment options, and our company.

Training:

We are not a typical warehouse company, meaning we don't have a big facility with a ton of dogs being kenneled. Our dogs are trained in, an in home environment with our certified trainers. The company over sees the training by doing weekly checkups on the dogs training, and each dog must pass a test before moving on to the next step in training. Whether we are training a dog for a college student or a child with siblings chances are the training atmosphere will be as similar to the applicants' home atmosphere. All our dogs go through our puppy raising program, basic obedience, and public access training. Although scent training is introduced early on in the training its finalized in the last part of training. They go through consists of scent and alert training in; night alerts, public access alerts, walking alerts, car alerts, alerting in restaurants, crowded places etc. The specific needs our applicant has, determines the training their dog goes through.

Throughout the entire training process, the dogs get tested biweekly, so we can see where the dog stands in his or hers current training program. This allows us to focus on both the dogs strength and weaknesses in training and adjust as we go. We highly believe in positive reinforcing, while correction the bad behaviors.

Benefits:

The benefits of a service dog can range from what they are trained to do, to companionship. Public outings become easier with their best friend by their side. Sleeping with a blanket of security has never felt better knowing there is someone constantly on the lookout for them, and being able to alert on high and lows. Payment Options

We proudly offer in house financing with interest free payment plans and other alternative ways to fund your service dog. Here's a quick overview of the payment plan options we currently offer. As well as information on outside financing, and alternative ways of funding your service dog.

In house financing in a nut shell:

All programs require a 30% deposit due along with the 2nd package (purchase agreement, acknowledgments, and our 2nd application) to get started. We have 1, and 2 year interest free monthly payment plans available.

Your monthly payments are determined by the total all inclusive price of your service dog minus the 30% deposit. We'd gladly break down the numbers for you and give you monthly payment due and the deposit amount. Your first payment is due after the initial month of the deposit. In order to qualify for the payment plans you must show proof of income and expenses. You can set up automatic payments through your bank or easy online payments through Paypal, you can also mail in check payments.

Fundraising:

Although we're not a none profit, about 80%-85% of our clients do fundraising to obtain their service dog. This is a great way not only to gather funds but also spread awareness of the your specific cause. Even though we don't offer any hands on fundraising help we do have a fabulous fundraising one on one consultation to help you get started. You can contact our office for more information and help on getting this going.

We don't put any restrictions on how you do fundraising or when you hold your events, fundraising in 100% in our clients hand. In most cases the donor writes out a check directly to us and we direct the funds towards your account.

Outside financing:

- 3. Tax Returns, Tax returns are a great way to help you put money towards your service dog weather its used for the deposit or as a part of the overall payment.
- 4. Although we by no means recommend the following some of our clients have gotten their funds from Home loans, 401k's or savings accounts. Depending on your own situation these options maybe an option for you
